


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


#### **13. How Is Method Performance** Measured?

- Outlier flags

   Predicted samples must fall

  within the calibration range – Mahalanobis Number  $(Global H) \leq 3.0$ 2.5 standard deviations
- 99.5% population inclusion Validated samples are occasionally run and the predictions are compared to historical values
- Method is expanded or improved if necessary





#### 14. Summary

- Rapid analysis of biomass with NIR/PLS
- Provides significant savings in time and money
- Maintains precision and accuracy of traditional methods
