KIDZ SHOULD:

- Never give out your last or family name, your home address or your phone number.
- Keep your screenname, user ID and password private.
- Look at a website's Privacy Policy to see how the site uses the information you give them.
- Talk about the site's Privacy Policy with your parents.
- Show your parents the sites you visit.
- Understand that websites must get your parent's permission before they collect many kinds of information from you.
- Leave a site if it makes you uncomfortable or asks for more information than you want to share.

PARENTS SHOULD:

Look for a website's privacy policy.

- Read the policy closely to learn the kinds of personal information being collected, how it will be used, and whether it will be passed on to third parties.
- Decide whether to let the website collect personal information from your child.
- Decide whether to let the website share your child's personal information with others.
- Ask to see the information your child has submitted.
- Understand that you may revoke your consent at any time and have your child's information deleted.
