Closures Lifted, Area Restrictions in Effect

Southwest and Northwest Zone Closures Lifted to Level 3; Central Zone Closure Lifted to Level 4; Eastern Zone Remains at Level 4

Missoula, Montana - Northern Regional Forester Dale Bosworth today approved removing closures for

National Forests in the central, northwest and southwest areas of Montana. This decision effectively re-

opens 16-million acres of National Forest System lands in Montana. Lower level restrictions will

remain in effect in all areas. The restrictions will go into effect at 12:00 noon, Tuesday, September 5.

Northwest and Southwest Zones in Montana will move into Level-3 Restrictions. This level of

restriction allows campfires and charcoal fires in developed/designated recreation sites and

campgrounds only. Hoot Owl Logging is allowed from 1am till 1pm. Level-3 restricts smoking and

off-road vehicles can travel on Forest Development Roads (FDRs), but there is no travel allowed off

roads.

Montana's Central Zone will move into Level-4 Restrictions. At this level of restriction: 1.) All

fires (campfires, charcoal fires and stove fires) are prohibited. 2.) Smoking is restricted. 3.) Woods

operations are not allowed. 4.) Off-road vehicles can be used only on Forest Development Roads

The Eastern Zone in Montana will remain in Level-4 Restrictions.

Coordinated restrictions are in place on public lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management, U.S, Fish and Wildlife Service, Bureau of Indian Affairs and State of Montana as well as private lands.

Specific areas within National Forests may be closed due to firefighter and public safety concerns presented by current active fires.
