Under section 312 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), and Title 8 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 312, an applicant for naturalization must demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the English language and United States history and government. However, section 312(b) of the INA provides that the English and civics requirements "shall not apply to any person who is unable because of physical or developmental disability or mental impairment to comply therewith." To qualify for an exception under section 312(b), an applicant must establish that he or she has a "medically determinable" physical or developmental disability or mental impairment. "Medically determinable" means that the disability or impairment, or combination thereof "results from anatomical, physiological, or psychological abnormalities which can be shown by medically acceptable clinical or laboratory diagnostic techniques to have resulted in functioning so impaired as to render an individual unable to demonstrate an understanding" of English and/or U.S. history and government.

Your N-648, therefore, was rejected as insufficient and you were deemed ineligible for an exception from the section 312 requirements based on the section 312(b) disability exception.
