Dear Power Supply Manufacturer or Other Industry Stakeholder:

Per EPA's memo dated March 22, 2004, attached is the electronic version of the single voltage external ac-dc power supplies test report. Manufacturers who would like to test and submit data for EPA's consideration in developing the ENERGY STAR specification for external power supplies are asked to use the attached Microsoft Access data input form when collecting data. Here are some tips on using the form:

- Laboratory and contact information is provided as an example; click on "New" at the bottom of the page to enter your specific testing information.
- Once you have completed each step, click on "Stop" at the bottom of the page to return to the main menu.
- After clicking on the last step "View Test Report", a default printer message will appear - click on "Yes" to print to your specific default printer.
