The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) invites offers to sell fresh citrus as indicated below and per the Announcement for use in child nutrition programs. Offers are due by 1 p.m., Central Time, **Thursday**, **October 28**, **2004**. Acceptances will be announced by midnight, **Wednesday**, **November 10**, **2004**. Deliveries are to be made from January 24, 2005 through April 27, 2005.

Offers are invited from the trade for 2,820 cases of fresh grapefruit in cartons to a shipping container.

No offer will be made to 8(a) vendors on this invitation.

VENDORS MUST BE GHP CERTIFIED PRIOR TO SUBMISSION OF BIDS.

Vendors who have not acquired the GHP certification will be deemed nonresponsive.

All prime vendors are reminded that they are prohibited from subcontracting with companies or individuals that have been suspended or debarred.

Bids must be submitted electronically via the Domestic Electronic Bid Entry System (DEBES) on the Internet. Offerors who submit bids using other than DEBES, will be deemed non-responsive.
