KC AREA MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO STEALING \$27,000 WORTH OF MOTOR VEHICLE PRODUCTS

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Kansas City, Mo., area man pleaded guilty today to stealing more than \$27,000 worth of motor vehicle products.

Kenny R. Borders, 32, of Kansas City, Mo., pleaded guilty before U.S. District Judge Howard F. Sachs this afternoon to theft of motor vehicle products from an interstate shipment of freight.

By pleading guilty, Graves said, **Borders** admitted that he stole motor vehicle products – valued at approximately \$27,583 – from a 53-foot Trailmobile trailer belonging to Waller Trucking Company, Inc., at the GEO Space Distribution Center, 601 South 291 Highway in Independence, Mo., between February 1, 2002 and May 7, 2002. The motor vehicle products included Armor All products, STP Fuel Injector & Carburetor Cleaner, Super Tech Oil Treatment, and Son-of-a-Gun products.

Graves explained that the theft was from an interstate shipment of freight from the Clorox Company in Oakland, Georgia, to Wal-Mart in Plainview, Texas.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Christina Y. Tabor. The case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Missouri State Highway Patrol.
