KC MAN SENTENCED FOR STEALING \$27,000 WORTH OF MOTOR VEHICLE PRODUCTS

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Kansas City man was sentenced in federal court today for stealing more than \$27,000 worth of motor vehicle products.

Kenny R. Borders, 33, of Kansas City, Mo., was sentenced by U.S. District Judge Howard F. Sachs this afternoon to five months in federal prison without parole, plus three months of home detention following his release.

On Feb. 14, 2003, **Borders** pleaded guilty to stealing the motor vehicle products from a 53-foot Trailmobile trailer belonging to Waller Trucking Company, Inc., at the GEO Space Distribution Center in Independence, Mo. By pleading guilty, **Borders** admitted that he stole various motor vehicle products from the trailer between Feb. 1, 2002, and May 7, 2002. The items included Armor All products, STP Fuel Injector and Carburetor Cleaner, Super Tech Oil Treatment and Son-of-a-Gun products. The motor vehicle products were valued at approximately \$27,583.

Graves explained that the theft was from an interstate shipment of freight from the Clorox Company in Oakland, Ga., to Wal-Mart in Plainview, Texas.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Christina Y. Tabor. It was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Missouri State Highway Patrol.
