KCK MAN SENTENCED FOR POSSESSION, INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE METH

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Kansas City, Kan., man was sentenced in federal court today for possession with intent to distribute methamphetamine.

Angelo A. Campos, 23, of Kansas City, Kan., was sentenced by U.S. District Judge Howard F. Sachs this afternoon to five years and 10 months in federal prison without parole.

On May 13, 2003, **Campos** pleaded guilty to being in possession with intent to distribute 50 grams or more of methamphetamine on Jan. 9, 2003. Specifically, he admitted that he was in possession of 107.99 grams of methamphetamine in Jackson County, Mo.

Campos was initially charged in an indictment returned by a federal grand jury on Jan. 21, 2003, in Kansas City, Mo.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Jess Michaelsen. It was investigated by the Kansas City, Mo., Police Department and the Metropolitan Methamphetamine Task Force.
