## FELON SENTENCED FOR ILLEGALLY PURCHASING GUN

**SPRINGFIELD, Mo.** – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Mountain Grove, Mo., man was sentenced in federal court today for illegally purchasing a firearm from A& H Gun and Pawn, located in Mountain Grove.

**Robert L. Gibbs**, 46, was sentenced this afternoon by U.S. District Chief Judge Dean Whipple to four years and nine months in federal prison without parole.

On Oct. 28, 2002, **Gibbs** pleaded guilty to a federal information charging him with making false statements in order to purchase a firearm on March 14, 2002. By pleading guilty, **Gibbs** admitted that he knowingly made false statements regarding his previous felony conviction. Under federal law, Graves explained, it is illegal for a convicted felon to purchase or possess a firearm or ammunition. Gibbs has a 1993 criminal felony conviction for assault.

This case was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and the Douglas County, Mo., Sheriff's Department.
