## SMITHVILLE WOMAN PLEADS GUILTY TO TRANSPORTING STOLEN PROPERTY IN \$260,000 CHECK FRAUD

**KANSAS CITY, Mo.** – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Smithville, Mo., woman pleaded guilty today to illegally issuing more than \$260,000 worth of checks drawn upon an Illinois bank, then depositing those checks into her personal bank account.

**Patricia Lee Hubbard**, 47, of Smithville, Mo., pleaded guilty before U.S. District Judge Fernando J. Gaitan, Jr., this morning to interstate transportation of stolen property.

**Hubbard** admitted that, while working as a controller for Grant Thornton, LLC, between July 1995 and May 1998, she unlawfully and without authorization issued checks drawn upon a bank account in Chicago, Ill. These checks were then deposited by **Hubbard** into her personal account at Platte Valley Bank. As a result, Graves explained, money was transferred from Illinois to Missouri.

**Hubbard** also admitted that the total loss to her victim is in excess of \$260,000.

**Hubbard** was originally charged in an indictment returned by a federal grand jury in Kansas City on April 15, 2003.

As a result of today's guilty plea, **Hubbard** could be subject to a sentence of 10 years in federal prison without parole, plus a fine up to \$250,000. The sentence will be determined according to the United States Sentencing Guidelines. A sentencing hearing will be scheduled after the completion of a presentence investigation by the U.S. Probation Office.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney David M. Ketchmark. It was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
