### KCK MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO POSSESSION, INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE CRACK COCAINE

**KANSAS CITY, Mo.** – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Kansas City, Kan., man pleaded guilty in federal court today to possession with intent to distribute crack cocaine.

**Bobby R. Leveringston**, 26, of Kansas City, Kan., pleaded guilty before U.S. District Chief Judge Dean Whipple this morning to possession with intent to distribute crack cocaine.

By pleading guilty, **Leveringston** admitted that he was in possession with intent to distribute crack cocaine on Nov. 17, 2002, in Kansas City, Mo. Specifically, **Leveringston** admitted that he possessed 25.1 grams of crack cocaine and 47.31 grams of cocaine at the Marriott Residence Inn, located at 2975 Main St., in Kansas City.

**Leveringston** was originally charged in an indictment returned by a federal grand jury on April 15, 2003, in Kansas City.

As a result of pleading guilty, **Leveringston** may be subject to a sentence of up to 40 years in federal prison without parole, plus a \$2 million fine. His sentence will be determined according to the United States Sentencing Guidelines. A sentencing hearing will be scheduled after the completion of a presentence investigation by the United States Probation Office.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Candace Cole. The case was investigated by the Kansas City, Mo., Police Department.
