TEXAS MAN SENTENCED FOR MARIJUANA CONSPIRACY

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that an El Paso, Texas, man was sentenced in federal court today for conspiracy to distribute marijuana.

Martin Martinez, 39, of El Paso, Texas, was sentenced by U.S. District Judge Ortrie D. Smith this morning to one year and one day in federal prison without parole.

On March 10, 2003, **Martinez** pleaded guilty to conspiring to distribute marijuana on Nov.5, 2002.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Jess Michaelsen. It was investigated by the Drug Enforcement Administration.
