MAN INDICTED FOR ROBBING NORTHLAND BANK

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced a defendant has been indicted for robbing Union Bank, located in the Northland.

Collin J. McDonald, 23, of Kansas City, Mo., was charged in an indictment returned by a federal grand jury today in Kansas City.

The federal indictment alleges that **McDonald** took, by force and intimidation, \$2,560 belonging to Union Bank, located at 9221 North Oak Trafficway in Kansas City. The indictment alleges that he took the money on Nov. 25, 2003.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney D. Michael Green. It was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Kansas City, Mo., Police Department.

Graves cautioned that the charges contained in the indictment are simply accusations, and not evidence of guilt. Evidence supporting the charges must be presented to a federal trial jury, whose duty is to determine guilt or innocence.
