## KC MAN SENTENCED FOR ILLEGAL FIREARM

**KANSAS CITY, Mo.** – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Kansas City, Mo., man was sentenced in federal court today for illegally possessing a firearm.

**Charles H. Shirley**, 25, of Kansas City, Mo., was sentenced by U.S. District Judge Fernando J. Gaitan, Jr., this morning to five years and four months in federal prison without parole.

On June 24, 2002, **Shirley** pleaded guilty to being a felon in possession of a firearm. By pleading guilty, Grave said, **Shirley** admitted that he was in possession of a Glock .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun on Feb. 27, 2002. Under federal law, Graves explained, it is illegal for anyone who has been convicted of a felony to be in possession of any firearm or ammunition. **Shirley** has a 1998 criminal felony conviction in Daviess County for possession of a controlled substance.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Gregg R. Coonrod. It was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Kansas City, Mo., Police Department.
