KC MAN INDICTED FOR BANK ROBBERY

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Kansas City, Mo., man was indicted by a federal grand jury today for robbing a Raytown, Mo., bank.

Troy A. Taylor, 31, of Kansas City, Mo., was charged with robbing the Bank of America, 10100 East 350 Highway in Raytown, on July 11, 2003, in an indictment returned by a federal grand jury meeting in Kansas City.

The federal indictment alleges that **Taylor** took \$3,124 by force or intimidation from tellers at bank.

Graves cautioned that the charge contained in today's indictment is simply an accusation, and not evidence of guilt. Evidence supporting the charge must be presented to a federal trial jury, whose duty is to determine guilt or innocence.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Curt Bohling. It was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
