## COLUMBIA, MO., MAN SENTENCED FOR DISTRIBUTING CRACK COCAINE

**JEFFERSON CITY, Mo.** – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Columbia, Mo., was sentenced in federal court today for distributing crack cocaine in Boone County.

**Donald Ray Wallace**, 36, of Columbia, Mo., was sentenced by U.S. District Judge Nanette K. Laughrey this morning to nine years and two months in federal prison without parole.

On April 18, 2003, **Wallace** pleaded guilty to distributing five grams or more of crack cocaine in Boone County on March 21, 2001. **Wallace** sold crack cocaine to a confidential informant for \$450, Graves said.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Jim Lynn. It was investigated by MUSTANG (the Mid-Missouri Unified Strike Team and Narcotics Group).
