JEFFERSON CITY MAN SENTENCED FOR SELLING COCAINE

JEFFERSON CITY, Mo. – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Jefferson City man was sentenced today for distributing cocaine.

David Tybalt Woodruff, 28, of Jefferson City, was sentenced by U.S. District Judge Scott O. Wright this morning to six months of in-home confinement and three years of supervised release to include substance abuse counseling.

On Oct. 4, 2002, **Woodruff** pleaded guilty to an indictment charging him with distributing cocaine on Dec. 17, 2001. By pleading guilty, Graves said, **Woodruff** admitted to selling 25 grams of cocaine to an undercover officer for \$980.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Jim Lynn. The case was investigated by the Mid-Missouri Unified Strike Team and Narcotics Group (MUSTANG).
