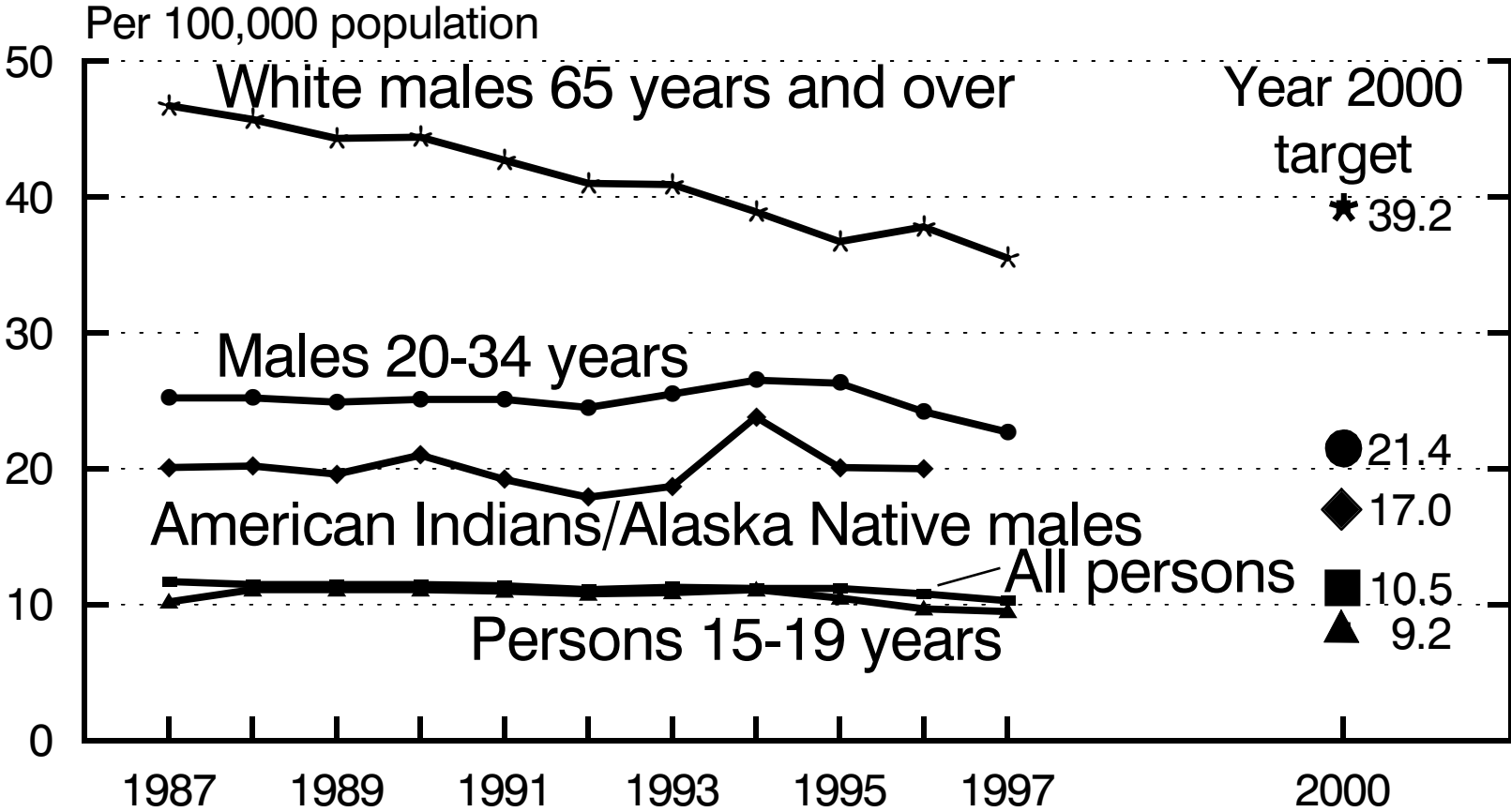


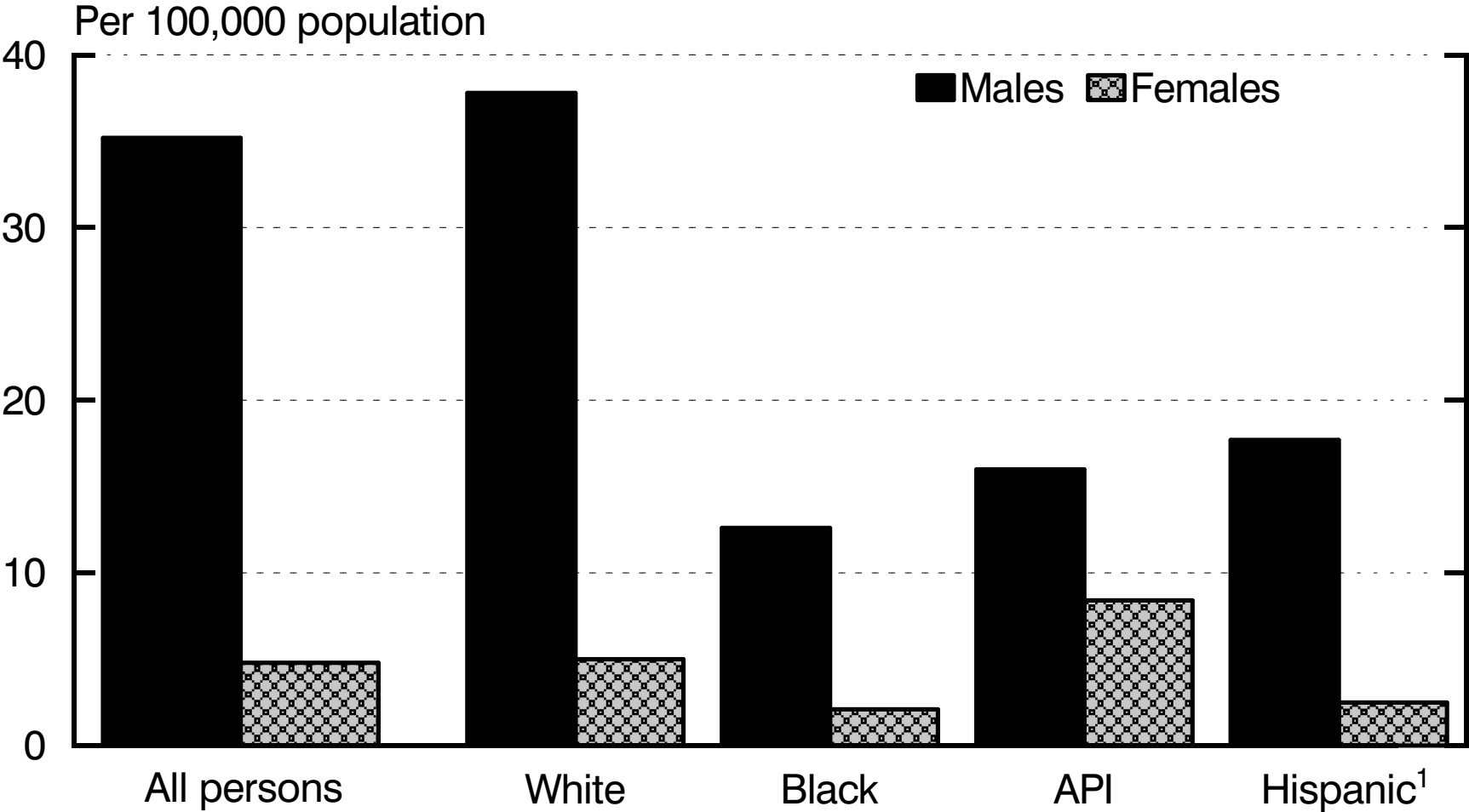

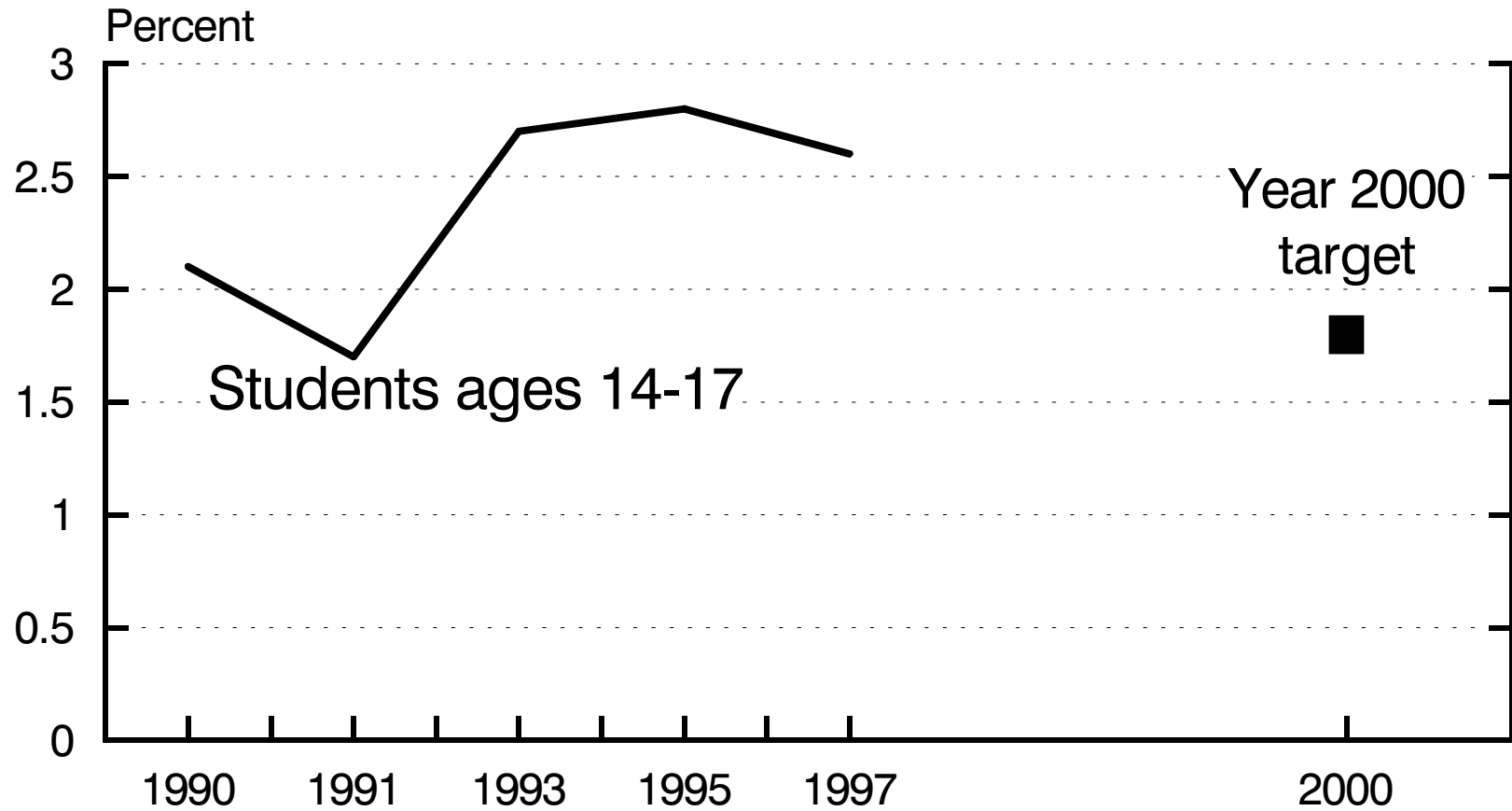

# Suicide among persons 65 years and over



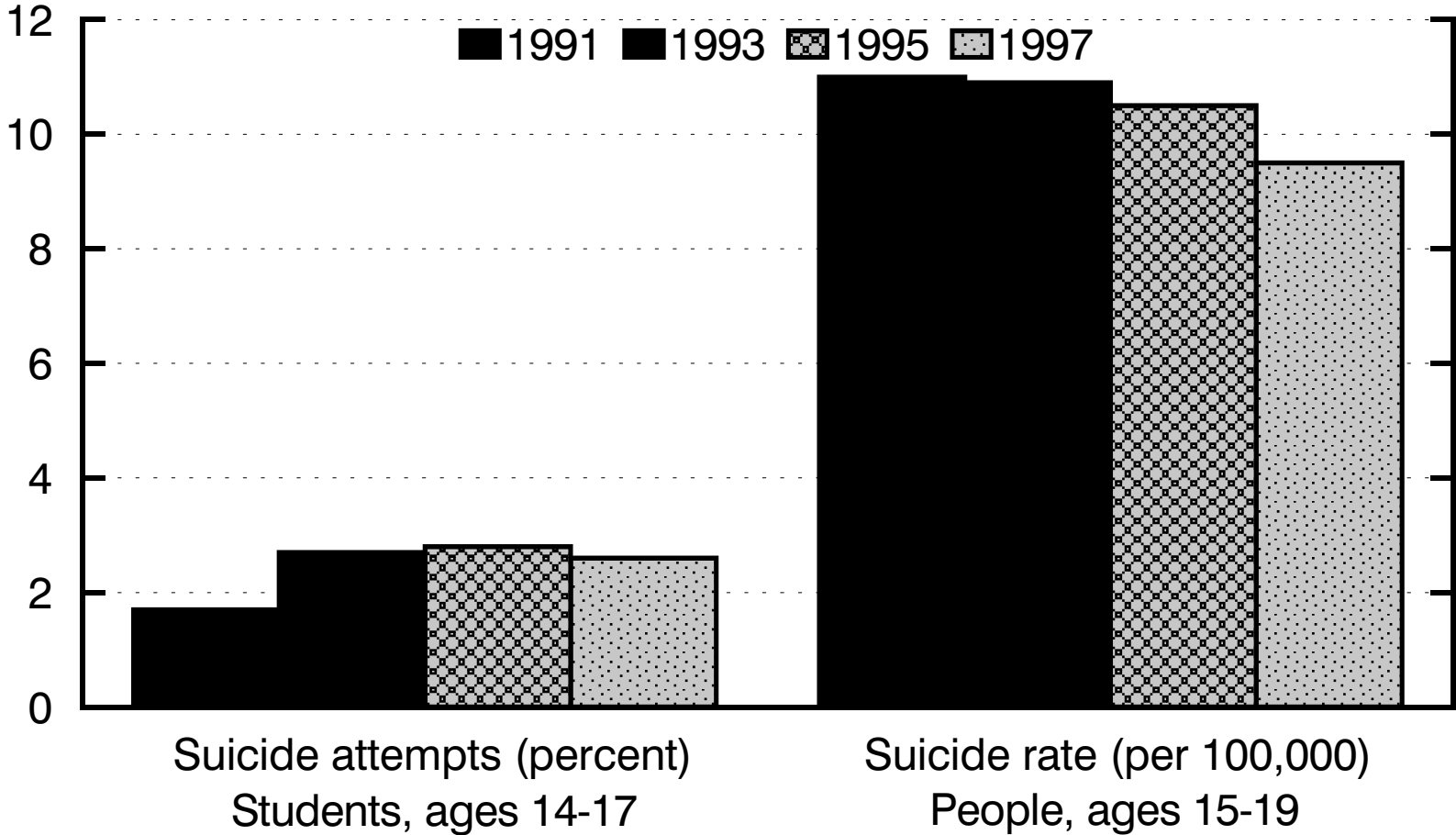

# Adolescent injurious suicide attempts (Objective 6.2)



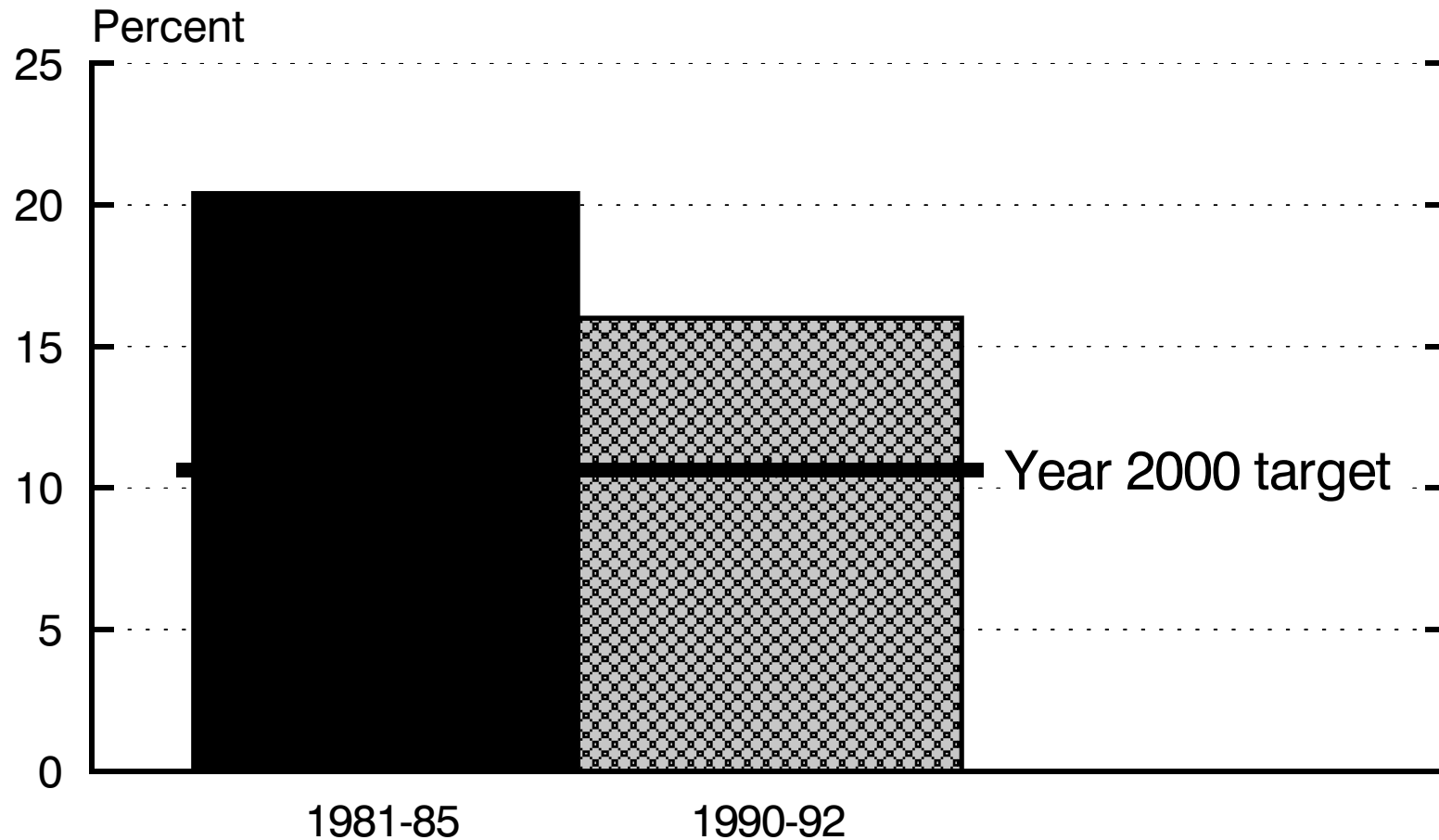

# Suicide attempts and suicides among adolescents



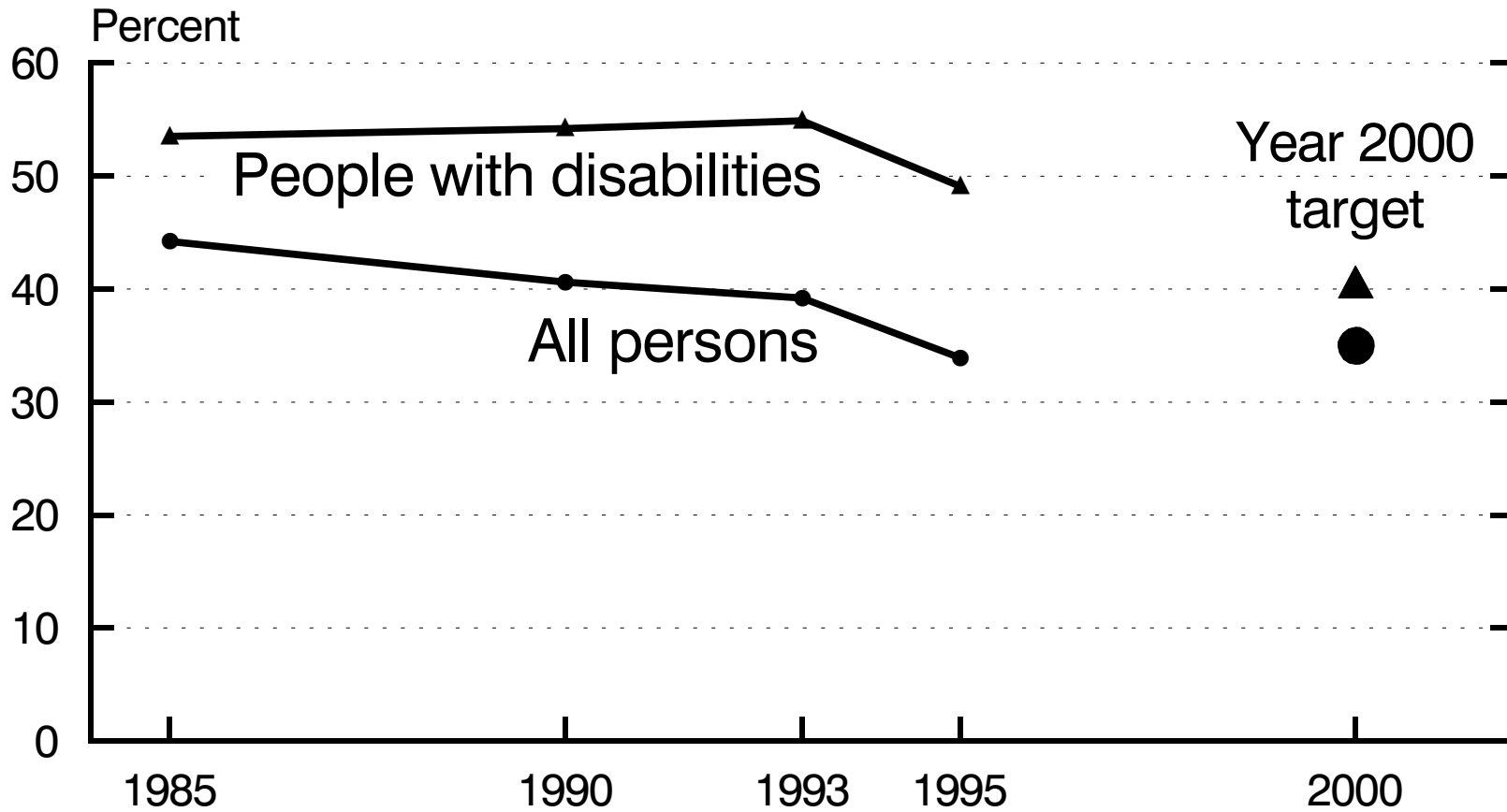

# Prevalence of mental disorders (Objective 6.4)



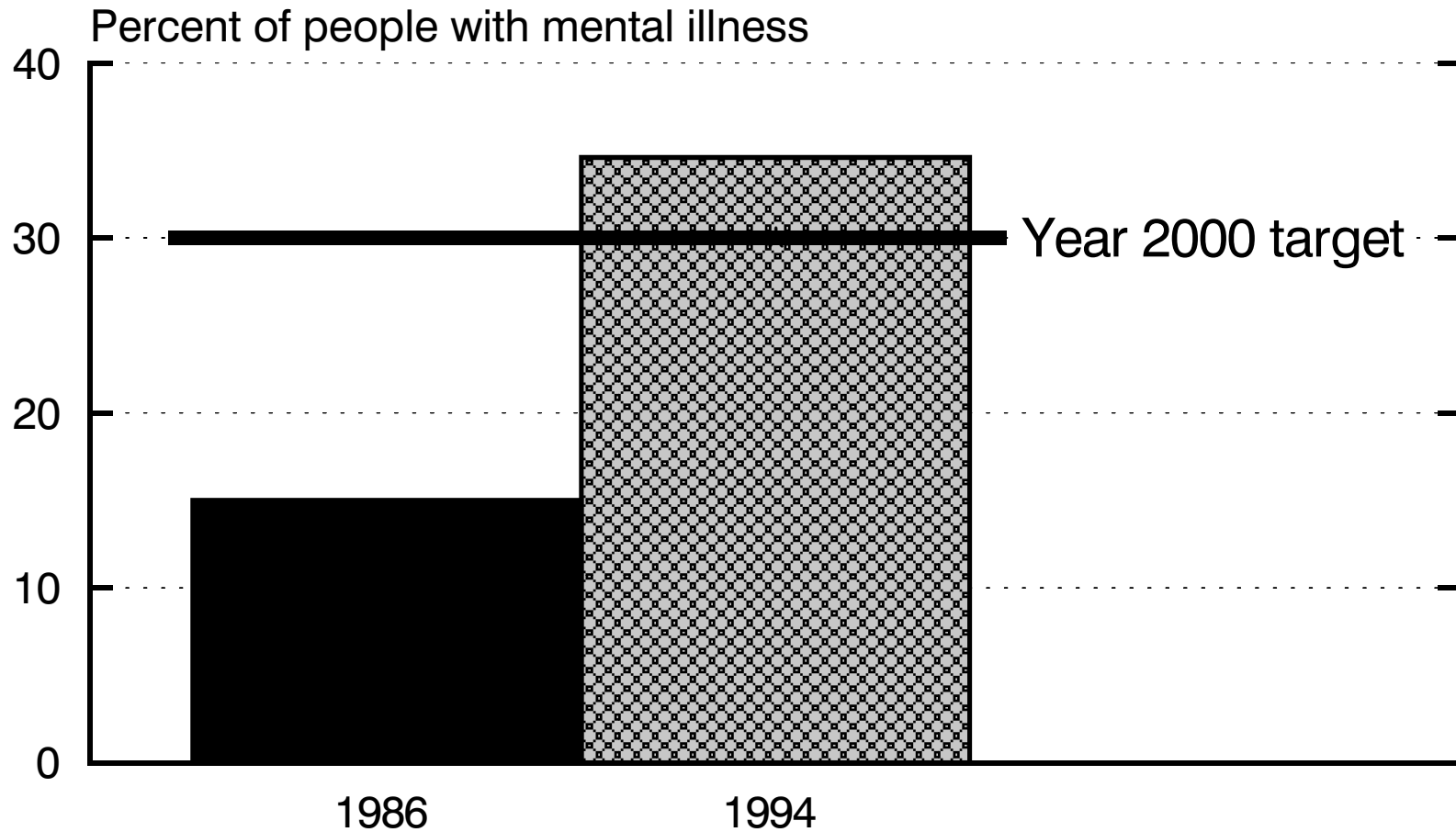

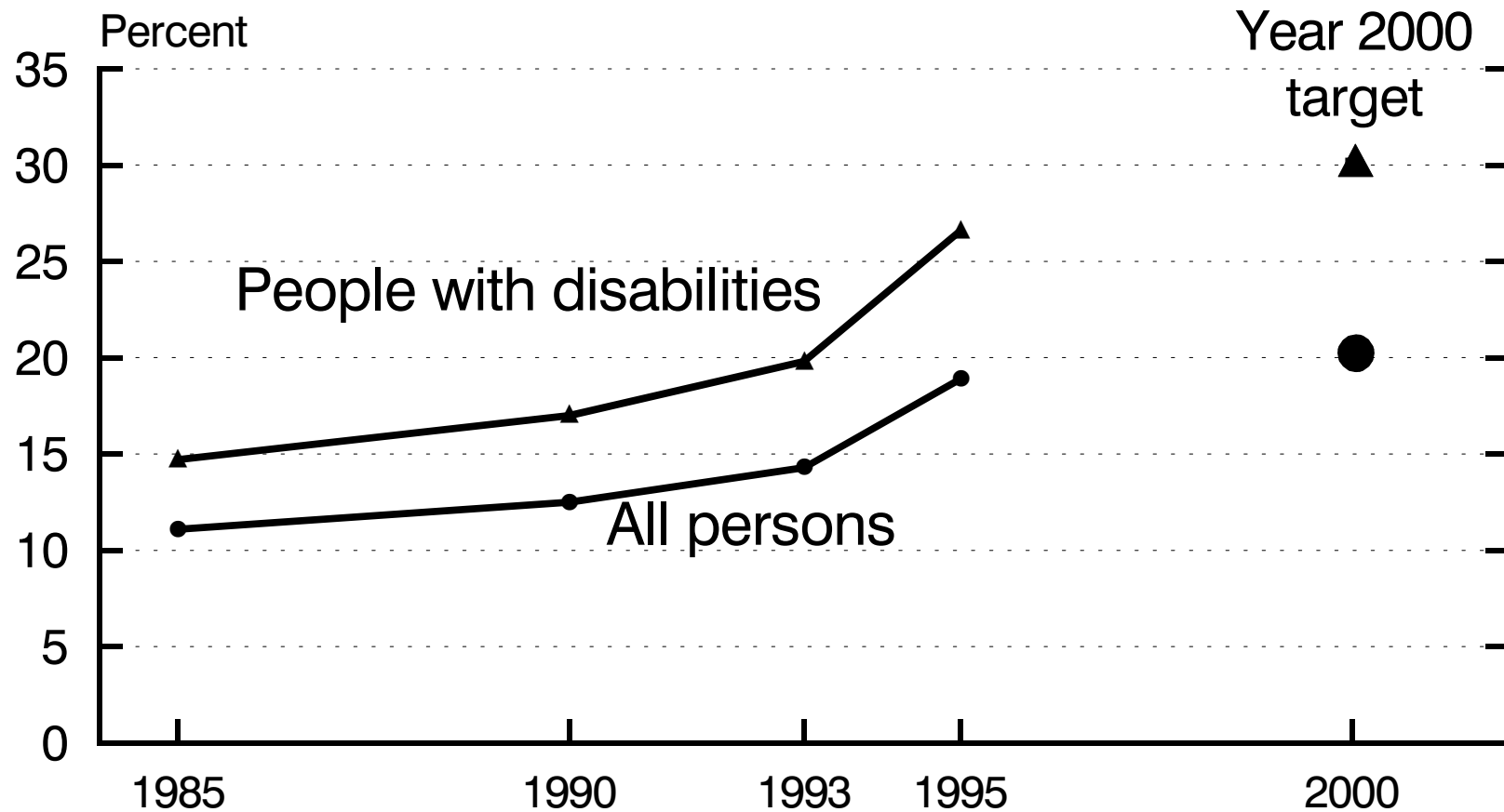
