Synoptic Discussion:

No changes in forecast reasoning. Surface high pressure will gradually weaken and move eastward. Winds will respond by becoming more S-SE. Otherwise, benign conditions expected. Main concerns will be the very slight chance for cumulus clouds and precipitation, both of which are flight through rules.
