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
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

# **Tobacco Market Review**

Burley, 2001 Crop









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The statistics on sales and markets in this review were compiled from reports and records of auction sales from the State Departments of Agriculture of Kentucky, Tennessee, North Carolina, and Virginia; from data furnished by marketing recorders employed through the offices of the Farm Service Agency, and from information received directly from markets and trade sources. The statistics on prices by grades were based on the compilation of auction data recorded from warehouse sales tickets from representative markets in the burley area.

# Review of the 2001/2002 Marketing Season

THE 2001-2002 BURLEY tobacco auction season posted the lightest sales volume and the second highest general average on record. The light volume at auction was due to the high volume of contract sales. Quality of this year's crop was better than last year, although loan receipts increased. Opening auction sales were held November 13, 2001 and final sales took place February 21, 2002 for a total of 44 days, three more than last year.

GROSS SALES AT AUCTION, which includes resales, amounted to 123,558,080 pounds, for a value of \$240,487,949, averaging \$194.64 per hundred. This was down 83 cents from the 2000 crop when 245.6 million pounds returned a record high average of \$195.47. Net sales totaled 113,342,353 pounds this season, compared with 223.5 million pounds a year ago. Gross auction and contract sales combined, amounted to 348,342,926 pounds, for a value of \$687,812,064, averaging \$197.45 per hundred. Other nonauction sales amounted to 5,568,517 pounds.

NEARLY TWO-THIRDS of the estimated crop production was marketed through 32 contract centers in 22 markets. Contract sales totaled 224,784,846 pounds, returning \$199.00 per hundred. Last year after sixteen weeks, 87.5 million pounds had been contracted for \$198.41 per hundred. Contract centers began accepting tobacco on October 29, 2001, and closed on February 28, 2002, after 70 sales days

BID AVERAGES WERE HIGHER for around 52 percent of the overall volume this season, lower for 33 percent, and unchanged for 13 percent. Advances were small, generally \$1 or \$2 per hundred. In heavy volume sales, a range of \$190 to \$194 covered lugs and cutters, while \$193 to \$207 was the span for leaf and tip grades. The majority of bid averages were either \$1 or \$2 above their supported levels.

THE BURLEY COOPERATIVES accepted 12,406,791 pounds, or 11.0 percent of net sales this season, compared to 19.3 million pounds, or 8.7 percent of net sales in 2000.

THE USDA ANNOUNCED final results on referenda held during March 2002, among various kinds of tobacco elegible for price support to determine whether they favored mandatory grading. A vote by a simple majority of eligible producers in favor was necessary for mandatory grading to become effective for the 2002 and subsequent marketing years. The final results indicate that 75 percent of burley tobacco producers voted in favor of mandatory grading.

SETS OF BUYERS decreased to 12 for the 2001-2002 marketing season, down from 30 sets that began the season in 2000. Several markets shared buyers, and Glasgow, Greensburg, Louisville, Russellville, KY; Morristown, Mt. City, Sweetwater, TN; Gate City, VA; W. Jefferson, NC; New Albany, IN did not operate this season.

NO-NET-COST ASSESSMENT was 2.0 cents per pound for the 2001 crop shared equally between the producers and purchasers. The fee for the 2002 crop will be 2.0 cents per pound, also shared equally. The fee for grading services of the USDA-AMS Tobacco Programs has been lowered to 90 cents per hundred pounds.

LOAN LEVEL AND 2002 QUOTA. A loan level of \$183.50 per hundred has been announced for the 2002 crop of Burley tobacco by the USDA - up 90 cents from 2001. The 2002 basic quota is 324.2 million pounds, down 7.8 million pounds, or 2.4 percent. The effective quota is estimated at 344.0 million pounds, or approximately 24 million pounds below last year.

MARKETING DURING THE 2000-2001 marketing season was conducted under Policies and Procedures recommended by the Burley Tobacco Advisory Committee and adopted and implemented by the Secretary of Agriculture. The major provisions were (1) a daily belt wide limit of 9.1 million pounds, and (2) daily sales opportunities per market within the limit of 9.1 million pounds to include any combination of producer, resale, and non-auction purchased tobacco.
