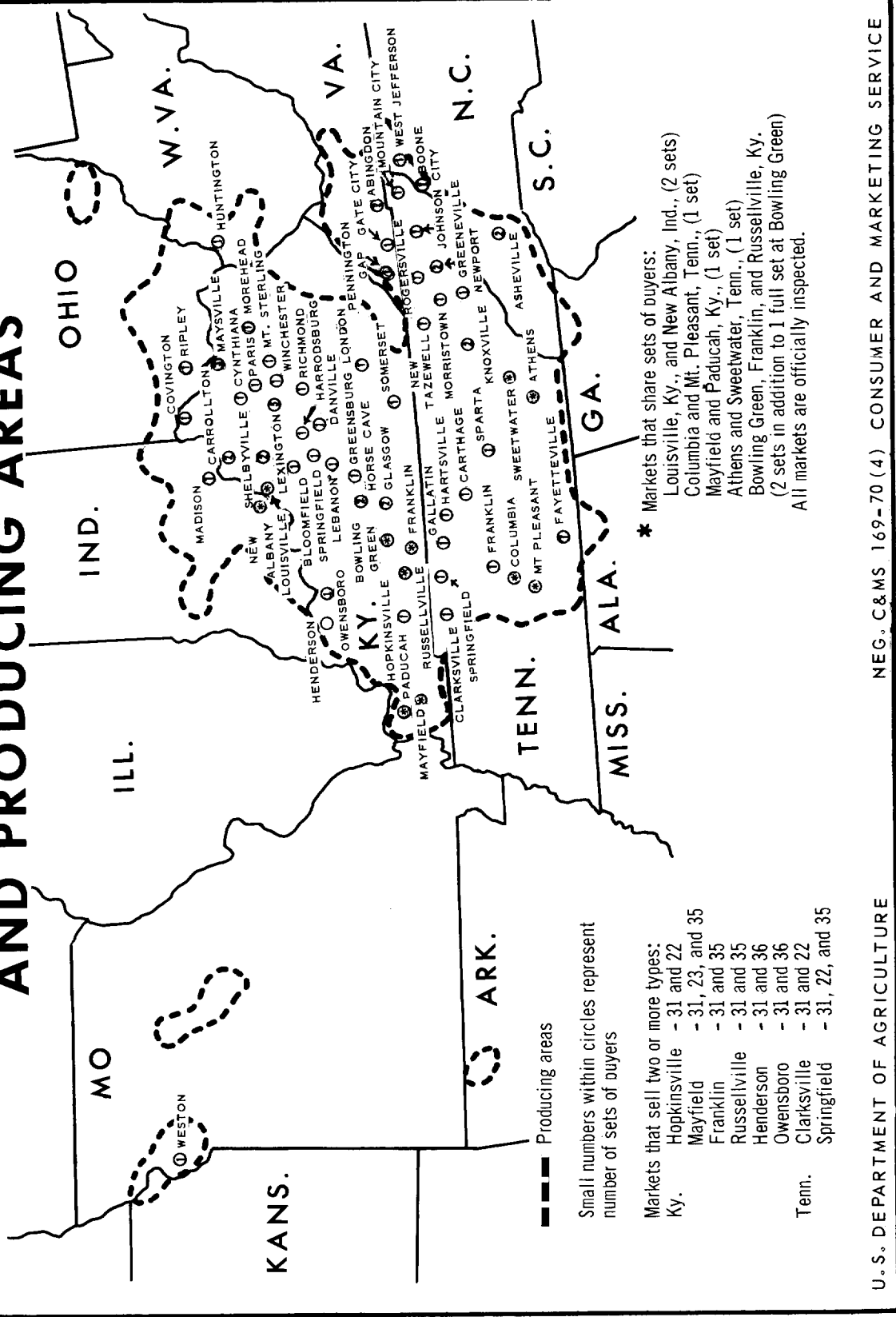

REVIEW OF THE BURLEY TOBACCO MARKETS  
1970-71 SEASON

Average price second highest  
All grade averages made substantial gains  
Quality not as good  
Sales volume and crop's value down

The average price paid for the 1970 Burley tobacco crop was the second highest ever recorded and all individual grade averages were up over last season's levels. Marketings contained more inferior tobacco and the general quality was not as good when compared to that of the preceding year's crop. The value of the crop declined sharply due to the light sales volume. The percentage of sales going under loan was the lowest since 1965.

The Consumer and Marketing Service of the United States Department of Agriculture reported a net average price of \$72.05 paid for the 1970 crop -- up \$2.48 over the 1969 average of \$69.57 and just \$1.62 per hundred pounds under the all-time high of \$73.67 set in 1968. Net sales 1/ totaled 560.7 million pounds (including about 9.6 million pounds of non-auction \* sales) --- down 33.0 million pounds from last season. The crop was valued at \$404.0 million, a drop of \$9.0 million from a year ago.

The marketing season opened on Monday, November 23, 1970 and sales ended on February 17, 1971 with a clean-up sale at Lexington, Kentucky. The maximum number of selling days was 33 compared to 42 a year ago. See table 1 on pages 7-8 for details on opening and closing dates of individual markets. About 84 percent of the 1970 crop was sold before the Christmas recess.

Deliveries of the 1970 crop to the Burley Associations under the Government loan program totaled 47.7 million pounds-- about 8.5 percent of the net sales. In the preceding season 158.5 million pounds or 26.7 percent of the sales went under loan. See table 4 on page 13 for details.

Grade prices. Average prices for all grades showed gains over last year's levels. Most gains averaged \$3 to \$5 per hundred pounds higher but some ranged up to \$8. Better grades of lugs and flyings showed the smallest gains. Some of the better grades were even with or only \$1 above their loan levels but a fairly large number of low quality grades were from \$10 to \$16 higher. See table 13 on pages 27-28 for details.

Composition of offerings. The quality of the 1970 offerings was not as good when compared to last year's crop as larger percentages of inferior tobacco lowered the general quality. More leaf and less tips, lugs and flyings were marketed. Colorwise, less buff and tannish red and more greenish and mixed was on the floors. Principal offerings consisted of low to fine leaf, low and fair lugs, fair flyings and no-grade. See table 14 on page 29.

The average loan level on the 1970 Burley crop was 68.6 cents per pound -- up about 4.3 percent over the 1969 level of 65.8 cents. Rates by grades ranged from 40 cents for N2G and N2R to 79 cents for C1F, X1L and X1F. The 1971 crop will be supported at 71.5 cents per pound, an increase of 4.2 percent over the 1970 average support price.

Regulations governing marketing operations. were about the same as those in effect for past seasons. Sales were conducted for 3½ hours per day at the rate of 360 baskets per hour with warehousemen having the option of operating on a basket or poundage basis. Those choosing the poundage option were limited to 340,200 pounds per day per set of buyers provided they did not exceed 1800 baskets.

Inspection and market news. Federal inspection and market news service, in effect on all markets, provide the grower with information as to the quality of his tobacco according to Federal grades and to the current average price at which such grades are selling. (All baskets of tobacco are inspected and graded by Government officials prior to sales, and price reports are made available to growers on the auction floors) The program operated under the authority of the Tobacco Inspection Act, (approved on August 23, 1935) offers free and mandatory inspection on auction markets designated by the Secretary of Agriculture for such service following favorable referendums of growers selling on such markets.

The level of price support is determined by the following method: The 1959 price support level is used as a base figure and adjusted each year in accordance with the change between the 1959 parity index (index of prices and wage rates) and the parity index for the three years just preceding the year for which the level is being determined. The 1970 level of 68.6 cents per pound was set by applying to the 1959 level the percentage comparison between (1) the 1959 parity index and (2) the parity index of the three year period 1967-69 ( $57.2 \times 120 = 68.6$ )

Marketing quotas and accompanying acreage allotments were in effect for the 1970 Burley crop. Marketing quotas based on poundage only were approved by 96.6 percent of the producers voting in a referendum held May 4, 1971. This program will be in effect for the 1971, 1972 and 1973 Burley crops and insures Government price support for the next three marketing years. Burley crops have been supported consecutively since 1939.

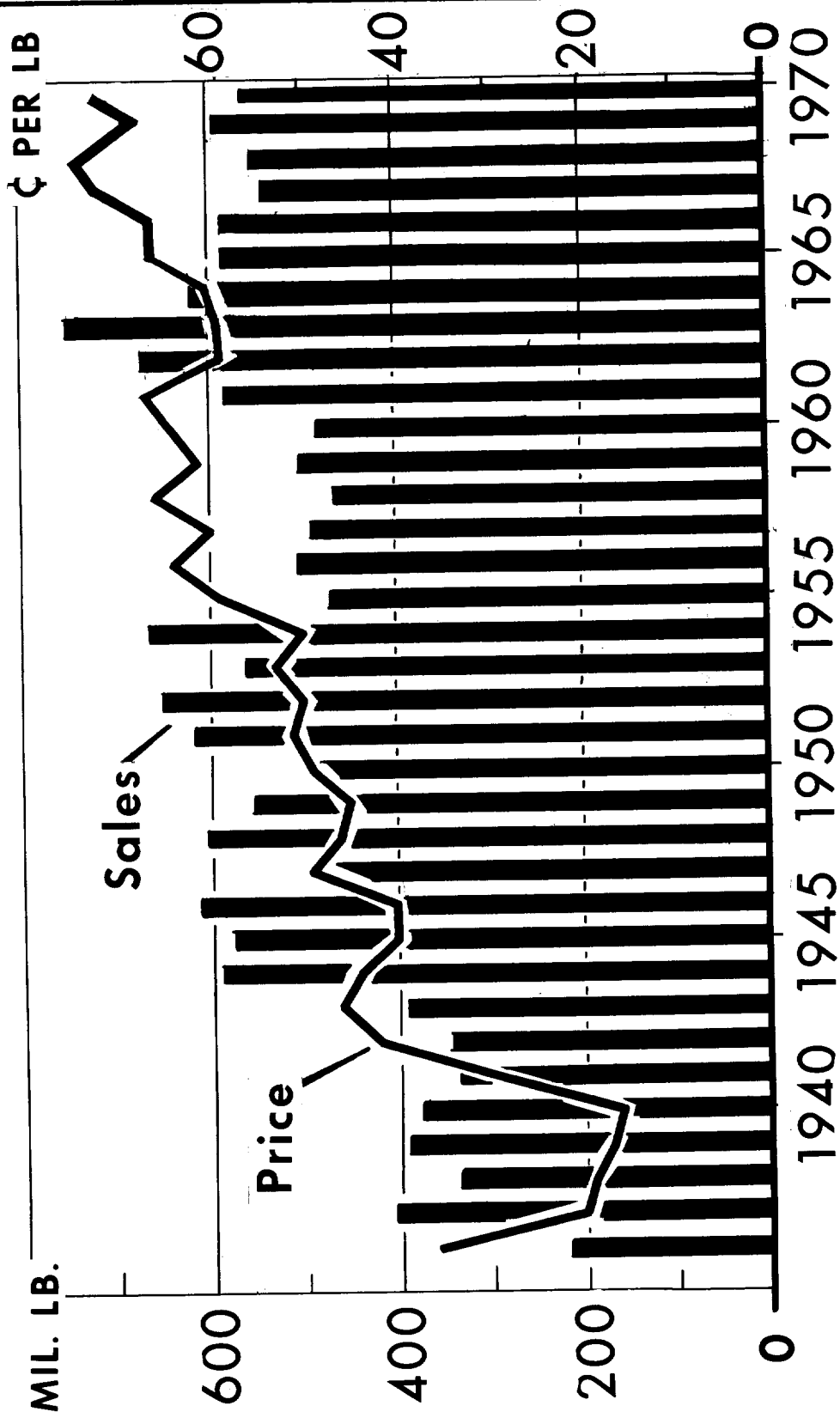
