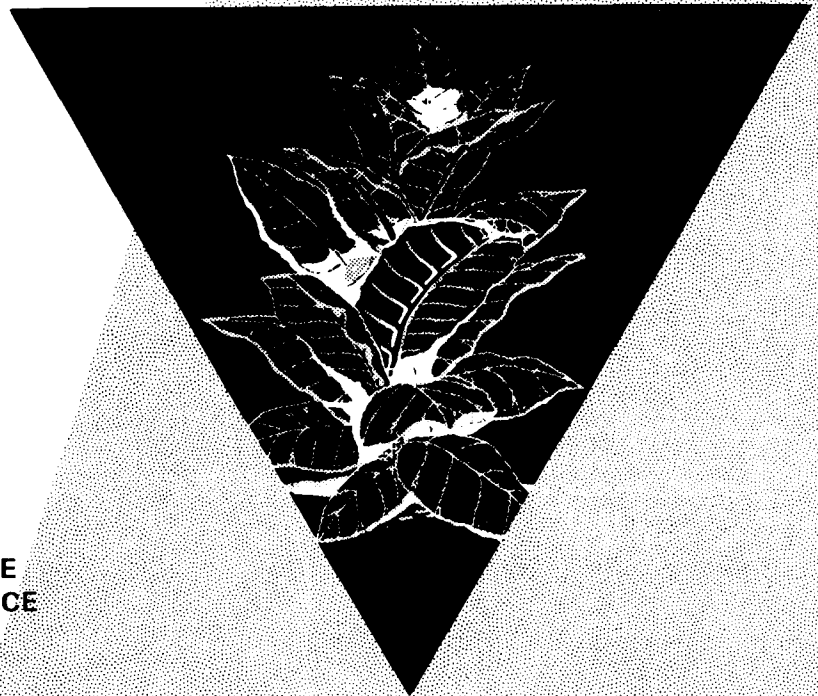

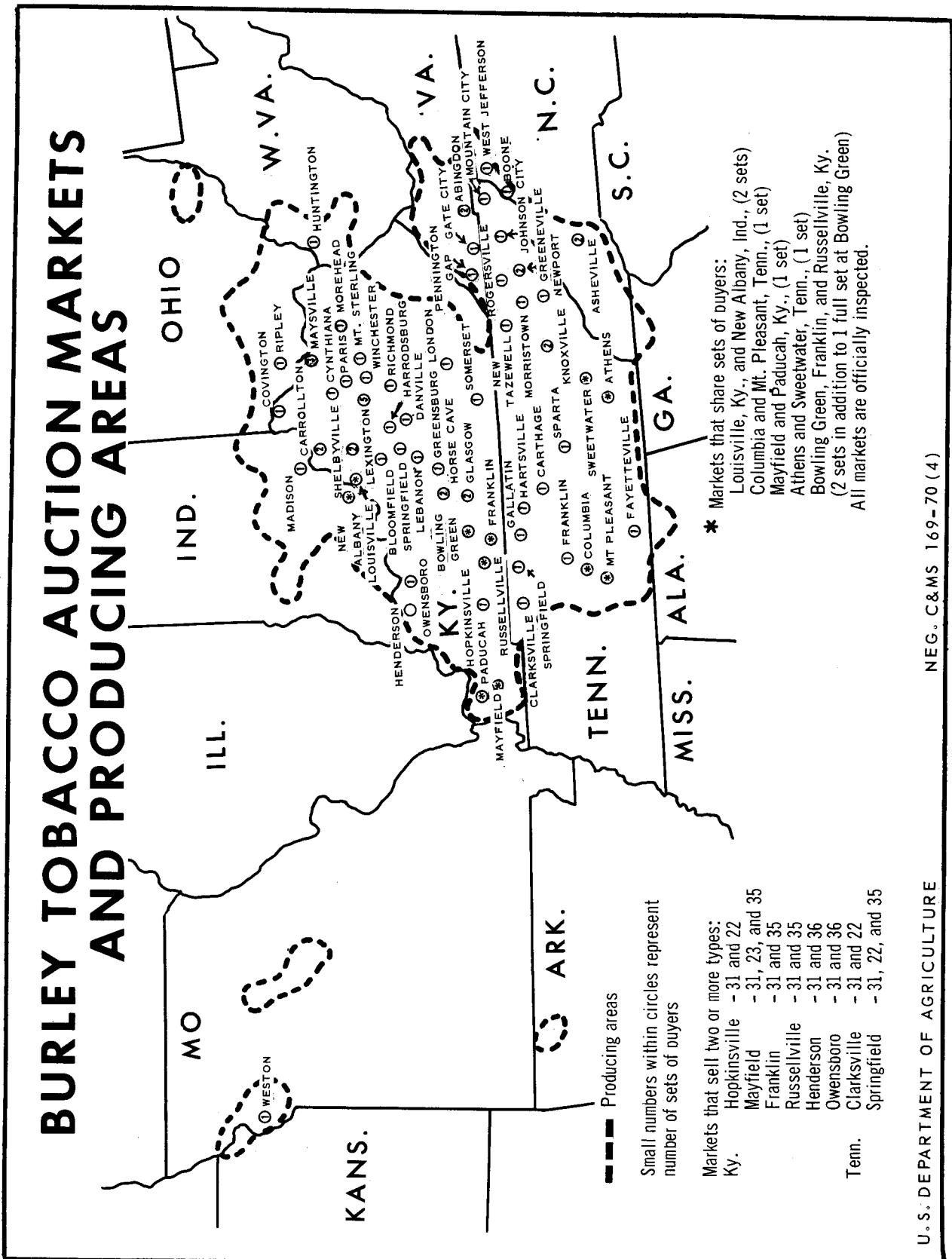

The 1972 crop of Burley tobacco was of excellent quality. But, although the net average price was good, it was only a fair second to the record average paid for the 1971 crop. Two factors influencing the price were the size of the crop (120 million pounds larger than last year) and humid weather conditions during the marketing season which raised the moisture content and reduced the redrying yield.

The Market News Service of the Agricultural Marketing Service reported a net average price of \$79.22 per hundred pounds for the 1972 crop--down \$1.66 from the record of \$80.88 paid for the 1971 crop. Producer's sales this season were 590.3 million pounds compared to 470.7 million during 1971-72.

The season average very nearly reflected the top price paid as over 80 percent of individual grades sold within a narrow range of \$79 to \$82 per hundred pounds. The largest declines from last season were for the lower qualities of tips and mixed grades.

The heaviest volume grades were B3F, C4F, M3E, B2F, and B4FR. This reflects the general increase in good and choice qualities over last season.

Government loan receipts this season were 22.8 million pounds, only 3.7 percent of total gross sales.
