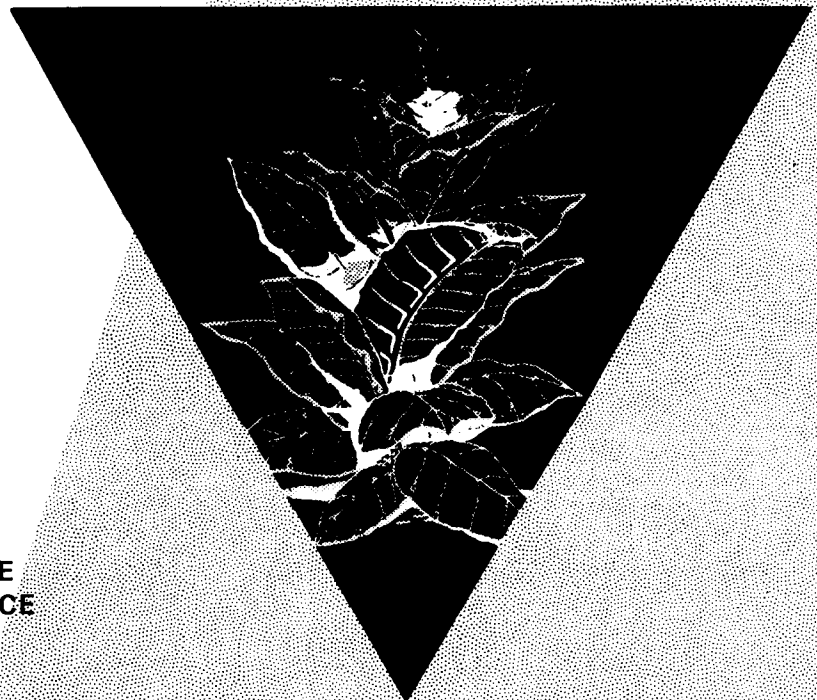

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The statistics on sales and markets in this review were compiled from reports and records of the State Departments of Agriculture of Kentucky, Tennessee, North Carolina, Virginia and West Virginia; and from data furnished by marketing recorders employed through county ASCS offices; and from information received direct from markets and trade sources. The statistics on prices by grades were based on the compilation of data recorded from warehouse sales tickets from representative markets in the Burley area.

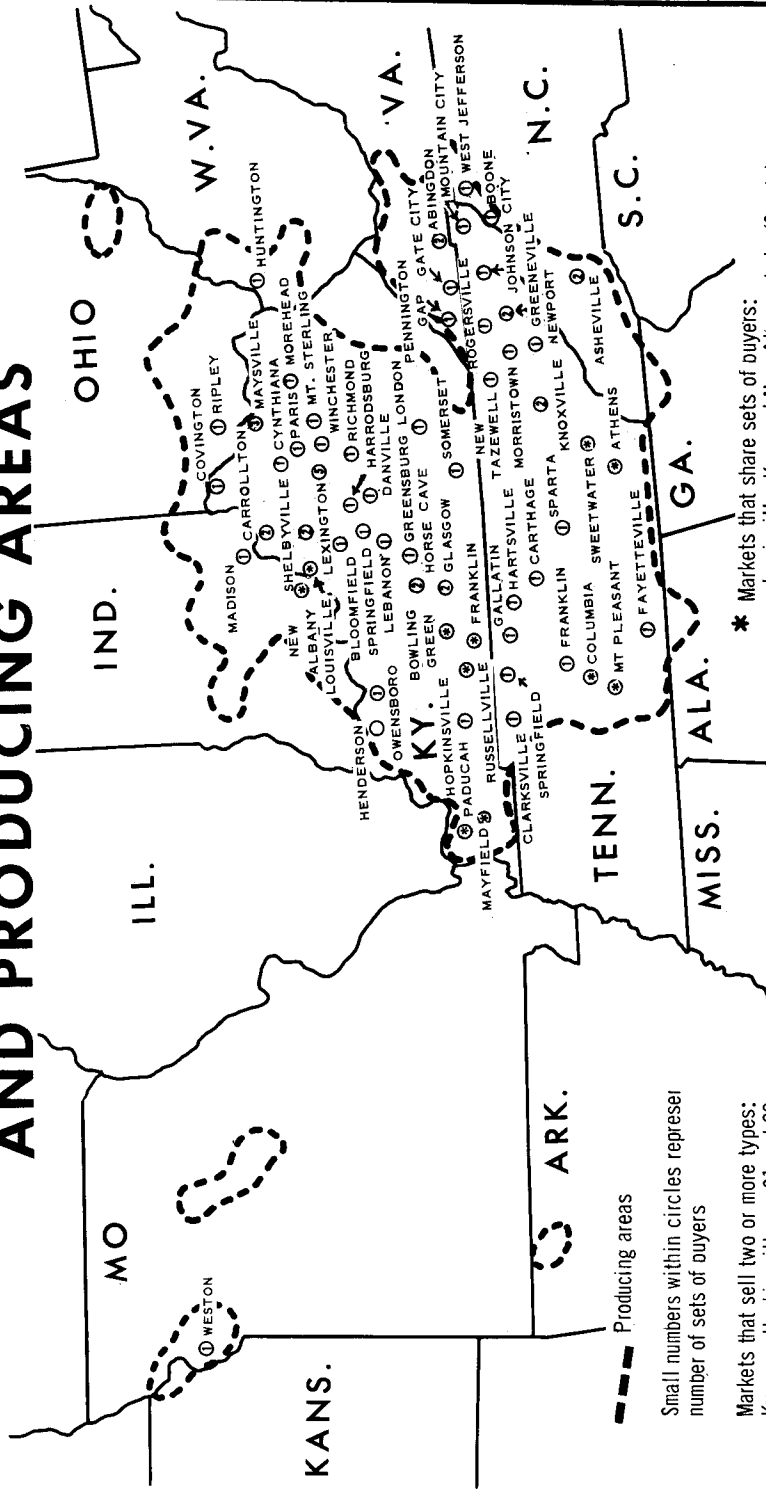

Highest Average Price On Record
Smallest Crop in 30 Years

The 1973 crop of Burley tobacco sold for the highest average price in history. This was the smallest crop since World War II; however, total value was the third largest of all time, surpassed only by the 1963 and 1972 crops. The strong demand held grade prices well above loan rates, permitting only a nominal amount of tobacco to be placed under Government loan.

The USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service reported an average price of \$92.92 per hundred pounds for the 1973 crop. This average represented a substantial increase of \$13.70 over the \$79.22 recorded the previous season. Producer sales totaled 462 million pounds compared with the 1972 crop which netted 590.3 million. Value declined 34 million dollars. The season began November 20 with sales in the belt averaging \$86.16. However, the tempo of the market moved rapidly upward, reaching a peak of \$99.13 on the seventh day of sales.

Auction bid averages by U.S. Standard Grades gained from \$10 to \$15 per hundred over the previous season. Over 85 percent of the tobacco averaged \$90 or above. During the high point of the season several grades averaged above \$1.00 per pound.

Quality of the 1973 crop differed only slightly from the year before. Heaviest volume grades were B3F, M3F, C4F, M4F, and B4FR. The trend toward less farm sorting and more mixed stripping continued as the proportion of offerings designated to the mixed group increased 6 percentage points over the year before, amounting to 22 percent of total sales.

Government loan receipts amounted to 650,721 pounds -- .13 percent of gross sales. This compares with 3.7 percent the previous season.
