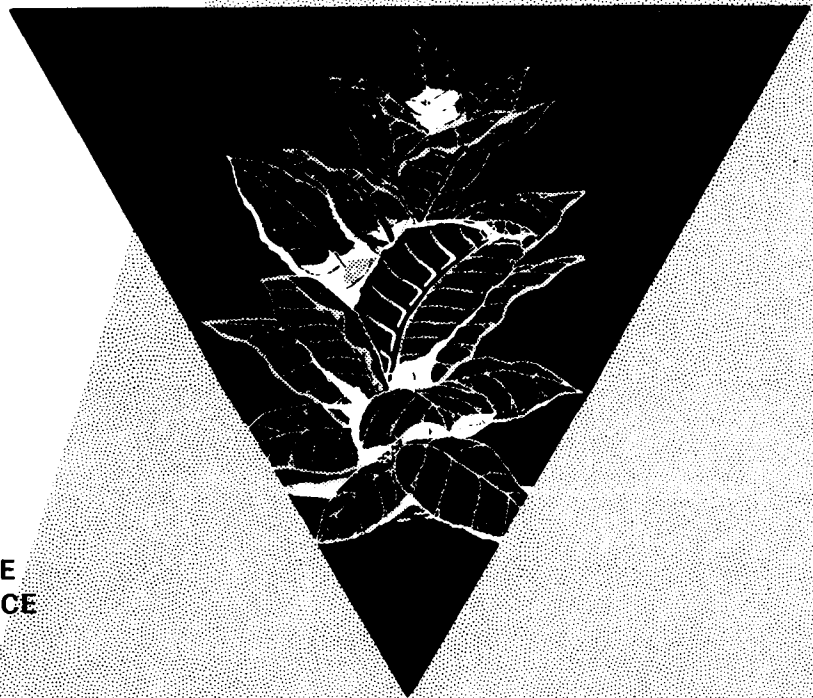

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The statistics on sales and markets in this review were compiled from reports and records of the State Departments of Agriculture of Kentucky, Tennessee, North Carolina, Virginia and West Virginia; and from data furnished by marketing recorders employed through county ASCS offices; and from information received direct from markets and trade sources. The statistics on prices by grades were based on the compilation of data recorded from warehouse sales tickets from representative markets in the Burley area.

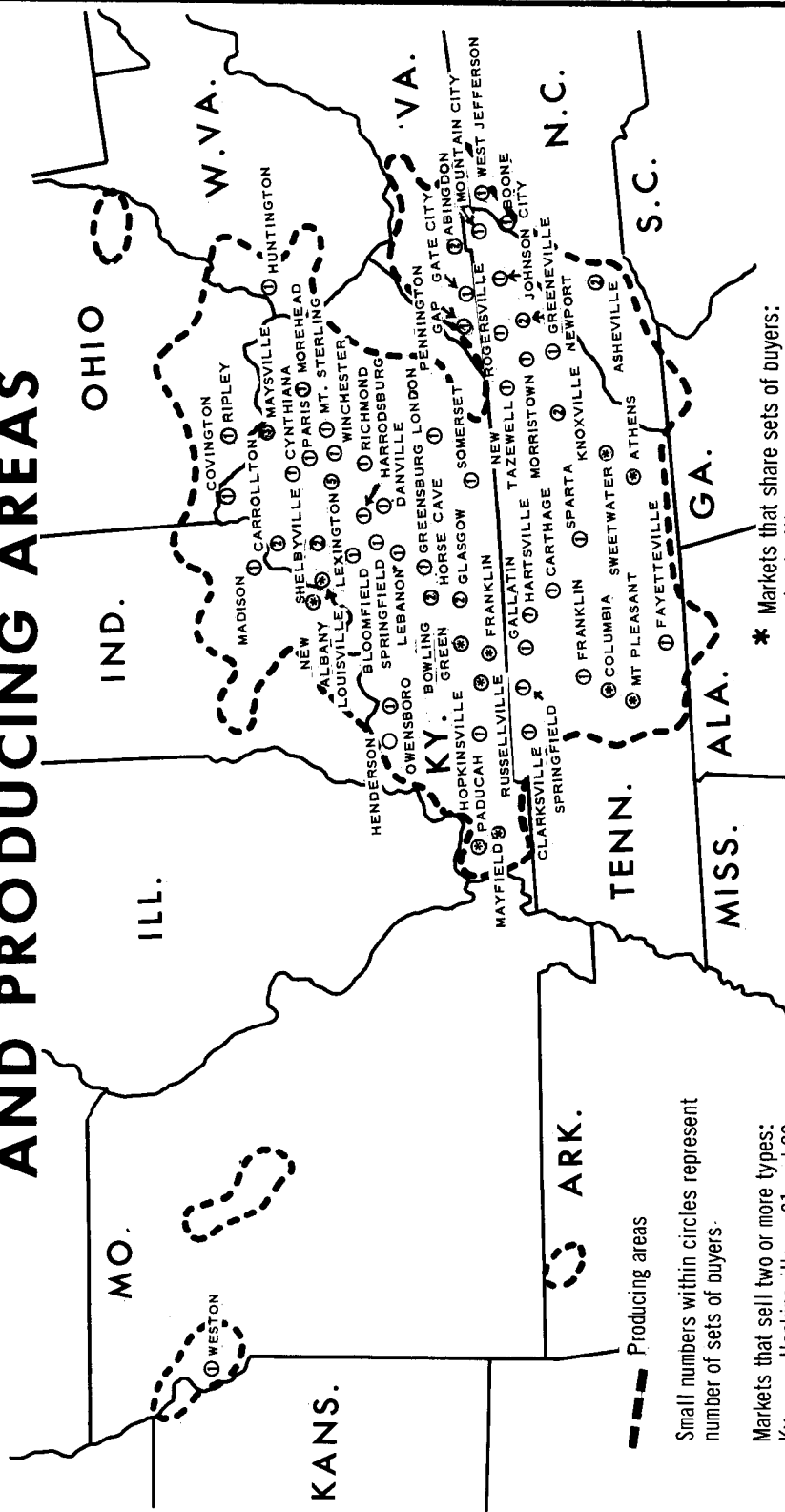

Highest Average Prices On Record

The 1974 Burley tobacco crop received the highest recorded prices in its history. Although quality was not as good, the average topped by far the previous record set for the 1973 crop. There was only a slight increase in the amount of tobacco that went under Government loan as a strong demand kept prices high.

The USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service reported an average price of \$113.86 per hundred pounds totaling \$688,508,952 for the 1974 crop. This represented the most money ever received by Burley growers and increased about \$258.6 million from last season. The highest daily average was \$120.18 set Monday, December 9. Producers sales totaled 604,700,447 pounds compared with 462 million the previous season.

Auction bid averages on most grades showed substantial gains of \$20 to \$24 per hundred over the preceding season. Even lower quality marketings went up around \$10. The practical top price this year was \$121 per hundred pounds.

Compared with the 1973 crop, more tobacco was designated as mixed, nondescript and no-grade. Also, less choice, fine and good quality was auctioned this year. Heaviest grades were M3F, M4F, B3F, C4F, and B4FR which accounted for 42.4% of the total volume. From a color standpoint, a higher percentage of variegated, mixed and green appeared for sale, while a large drop occurred for tan.

Government loan receipts amounted to 0.4 percent of sales compared with 0.1 percent last season.
