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The statistics on sales and markets in this review were compiled from reports and records of auction sales from the State Departments of Agriculture of Kentucky, Tennessee, North Carolina, Virginia and West Virginia; and from data furnished by marketing recorders employed through county ASCS offices; and from information received direct from markets and trade sources. The statistics on prices by grades were based on the compilation of auction data recorded from warehouse sales tickets from representative markets in the Burley area.

Prices lower for the 1975 Crop of Burley Tobacco

Grade averages were down \$3 to \$9 per hundred in most cases compared with last season. The highest grade average was \$115 per hundred. The practical top price was \$117 and occurred after the Christmas holidays.

Growers received an average price of \$105.56 per hundred for 634,764,000 pounds (producers' sales at auction). Last season 604,700,000 pounds returned an average of \$113.86 per hundred. Although the average dropped considerably this year, total value received was down only around \$2 million due to increased poundage.

Overall, quality showed little change. There was a smaller percentage of tobacco designated as mixed with more straight grades.

Loan receipts increased to 7.5 percent of sales this season compared with 0.4 last year. The majority of marketings received by the Burley Association was lower mixed grades and nondescript.

The loan level for the 1976 crop of Burley has been increased to \$109.3 per hundred pounds.
