Duties

- 1. Coordinating and transporting students to designated areas.**
- 2. Chaperone and maintain the security of the students between the hours of 8 am – 5 pm, at minimum; AND accompany students to act as additional chaperones on off-campus trips.**
- 3. The students you will be working with will be between the ages of 12 – 16 and from culturally diverse backgrounds. Realize that these students are NOT in college and will require more assistance and patience on your part.**
- 4. There will be no shouting or profanity used in the presence of the students. Reprimand and/or dismissal will result if this occurs.**
- 5. Be knowledgeable in the areas of education, diversity and/or psychology to increase the learning experience. In addition, you will be responsible for assisting in the completion of exercises and rap sessions to identify, accept and appreciate diversity among racial groups.**
- 6. Be familiar with mainstream topics of concern to this age group of students.**
- 7. Be able to be an impartial counselor to ALL students, not a particular group (i.e. boys, girls, particular ethnic group).**
- 8. Desirous that counselor have some animal handling skills. This is an Animal Science/Veterinary Medicine focused camp so we will be constantly working with animals.**
