### DOMESTIC ORIGIN VERIFICATION SYSTEM (DOVS) PROGRAM

#### • What is DOVS?

DOVS is an AUDIT-based program to verify contractors', subcontractors', or suppliers' systems for assuring that only domestic origin fruits and vegetables are delivered to the USDA.

#### • How does the DOVS program benefit you?

- 1. It greatly reduces the paperwork, especially for entities with multiple contracts that are performing trace-back on every contract.
- 2. Once you have the DOVS in place, trace-back for every contract is no longer needed.
- 3. DOVS participants will be listed on the USDA Commodity Procurement Branch Website, when developed.

# • Will trace-back on every contract still be an acceptable method of meeting the domestic origin requirement?

Yes. You can choose either the DOVS program or trace-back. Also, if a contractor, subcontractor, or supplier is not accepted into the DOVS program, the applicant will be required to perform trace-back on every contract.

#### • How many audits will be conducted?

One validation audit will be conducted annually. High-risk applicants, those who purchase, handle or store imported fruits or vegetables similar to or the same as those provided to USDA under contract, will have an additional follow-up audit. About 10 percent of all other DOVS suppliers will be audited each year. USDA reserves the right to audit more frequently, if deemed necessary.

#### • What do you need to do to participate in the DOVS program?

- 1. Request and fill out the DOVS Questionnaire, then submit it to Renee Wassenberg (see contact information on front).
- 2. Have your facility audited by USDA.
- 3. Correct deficiencies found during the audit.

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
