

Sexual Intercourse, by Grade


Percent of 9th and 12th grade students who have had sexual intercourse, 1991-2001


Four or More Partners, by Grade

Percent of 9th and 12th grade students who have had sexual intercourse with four or more partners, 1991-2001




Condom Use

Contraceptive Use at First Sex


Contraceptive use at first sex among females ages 15-19
