OFFER TO BUY: Bulk Potatoes for Processing

The Department of Agriculture announced it is planning to purchase bulk potatoes for processing for donation to the Child Nutrition Program according to Robert C. Keeney, Deputy Administrator, Fruit and Vegetable Programs, Agricultural Marketing Service.

The anticipated purchases will be made from offers that must be submitted on a delivered-to-destination price basis. Deliveries will be required from June 16-30, 2004.

Products, container sizes, and approximate quantities sought are as follows:

Invitations to bid, including final details and specifications, will be sent to processors. **Bids must be submitted electronically via the Domestic Electronic Bid Entry System (DEBES) on the Internet. Offerors who submit bids using other than DEBES, will be deemed non-responsive. Offeror must be assigned a Logon ID by USDA to access the site.
