Request For Proposal (RFP), Amendment No. 4

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Farm Service Agency (FSA) is seeking qualified sources for a potential performance based commercial services contract to 1) receive and store commodities for multi-food shipments, 2) accept orders from entities via an Internet based system, and 3) deliver the orders.

This is to notify you of the November 4, 2002 posting of Amendment No. 4, to the RFP. The Amendment is issued to provide a revision to the Contractor's required Quality Assurance/Quality Control Plan (QA/QC), which covers all performance standards to include a Security Plan as outlined in Section H, Item H.32.

The Proposal due date remains December 2, 2002 at 4:30 p.m. local Kansas City time. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
