NOTICE TO THE CHEESE INDUSTRY

To: Bulk Cheddar Cheese and Barrel Cheese Suppliers

Subject: Moisture Adjustment Cheese Price Chart (Form FSA-150) Formula

The Moisture Adjustment Cheese Price Chart does not list all possible base prices; therefore, this notice is issued to provide the formula used to calculate moisture-adjusted prices.

The contract price per pound will be adjusted for moisture content, in accordance with the contract, using the following Moisture Adjustment Cheese Price Chart formula:

Formula: 100 % - % moisture 1/x base price $\div 61\% 2/3/$

Example: $100 - 37.7 \times \$1.1220 \div 61 = \1.1459

1/Cheese which contains less than 37.8 percent moisture.

- 2/61% is a constant which represents the minimum total solids.
- 3/ Result is rounded to the nearest fourth digit to the right of decimal. Fifth digit of 5 or more is rounded up, 4 or less is rounded down.
