From Savanna (4 total miles):

- 1: Head **SOUTH** on Rt 84 - 3.5 miles
- 2: Turn **RIGHT** (SW) onto Riverview Rd - .5 miles

From Fulton (12 total miles):

- 1: Turn **LEFT** (North) onto Rt 84 - 12 miles
- 2: Turn **LEFT** (SW) onto Riverview Rd - .5 miles
