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PERFORMANCE GOAL SPECIFICATION (PGS)

1.0 Introduction

The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) Strategic Plan identifies and describes the basis for its mission, vision, and values for the future. NARA's plan identifies efforts under way to meet objectives, such as progress toward creating a viable Electronic Records Archives (ERA), implementing initiatives to redesign Federal records management, and making an increasingly number of records and services available to our customers through the Internet.

1.1 Purpose

The ERA Performance Goal Specification (PGS) is meant to provide performance goals and objectives that are to be met through the successful analysis, design, and implementation of the ERA system. These metrics specifications convey the purpose of each measure to be captured and the formula that will be applied. Successful implementation of the requirements as specified in the ERA Requirements Document (RD) will ensure that these performance goals of the ERA system will be achieved. The ERA PGS is considered Government Furnished Information (GFI) and is current at the time of the ERA Request For Proposal (RFP). The ERA PGS should be used, in conjunction with the ERA RFP materials and directions to offerors, by the integrators in preparing the technical and cost approaches for their ERA proposals.

1.2 ERA Program Overview

ERA will be a comprehensive, systematic, and dynamic means for preserving virtually any kind of electronic record, free from dependence on any specific hardware or software. The ERA system, when operational, will make it easy for NARA customers to find records they want and easy for NARA to deliver those records in formats suited to customers' needs.

2.0 **Document Assumptions**

The following assumptions were made during the development of this document.

- The paper's intended audience is the ERA development contractor(s) and the ERA Program Management Office (PMO).
- The paper is meant to provide guidance for the proposal phase of the ERA program. It is expected that the metrics specifications contained herein will be fully defined during the Analysis and Design phase of the ERA project.
- The paper reflects the goals and performance objectives as delineated in the NARA Strategic Plan.
