

MARKINGS AND LABELING	Transport enclosures must be properly labeled. [3.14, 3.36, 3.61, 3.81, 3.113, 3.137]
Criteria	<p>A removable transport enclosure is properly labeled for all covered animals if it contains:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• markings on the top and one or more sides of the enclosure• directional arrows indicating the upright position• the words (see page 13.5.2)<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ “Live Animal”▶ in letters at least 1" in height▶ on top of the enclosure and on one or more sides
Species Specific	<p>Nonhuman Primates [3.87(f)] Removable and permanently affixed transport enclosures must contain the words in English “Wild Animal” or “Live Animal”.</p> <p>Marine Mammals [3.113(f)] The transport enclosure, when not permanently affixed to the cargo space, must be marked:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• with the words “Live Animal” or “Wild Animal”• on top (when present), and• on at least one side, or• on all sides whenever possible <p>Other Animals [3.137(e)]</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The words “Wild Animal” may also be used.
