Members	<ul> <li>The IACUC must be composed of: [2.31(b)(2)]</li> <li>a Chairperson</li> <li>at least one Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM)</li> <li>at least one nonaffiliated member</li> <li>NOTE: To be a valid IACUC, all three positions must be filled.</li> <li>Although not specifically prohibited by the AWA, APHIS strongly discourages one person from filling more than one of these positions, such as: [Policy #15]</li> <li>the DVM being the Chairperson</li> <li>the nonaffiliated member being the Chairperson</li> <li>Note: APHIS also strongly discourages the research facility's Institutional Official from being the Chairperson or DVM.</li> <li>If the IACUC consists of more than three members, not more than three members can be from the same administrative unit of the research facility, such as: [2.31(b)(4)]</li> <li>Biology Department</li> <li>Cardiology Department</li> </ul>
Chairperson	<ul> <li>The Chairperson is responsible for all activities of the IACUC including, but not limited to:</li> <li>scheduling meetings</li> <li>setting the agenda for meetings</li> <li>sending a list of protocols to be reviewed to members</li> <li>moderating the meetings</li> <li>ensuring the research facility's compliance with the AWA and its regulations and standards</li> <li>keeping records of activities</li> <li>informing the Principal Investigator of the IACUC's decisions regarding his/her protocol</li> <li>sending the required reports to the Institutional Official</li> <li>Note: The Chairperson may delegate one or more of these activities to other IACUC members or research facility staff.</li> </ul>

Doctor of Veterinary Medicine	<ul> <li>The Doctor of Veterinary Medicine must have: [2.31(b)(3)(i)]</li> <li>training or experience in laboratory animal science or medicine, and</li> <li>direct or delegated responsibility for activities involving animals at the research facility, and</li> <li>ability to critically review a protocol for veterinary care issues</li> <li>NOTE: A research facility's Attending Veterinarian may fulfill the role of the DVM on the IACUC or the position may be filled by another veterinarian.</li> </ul>
Nonaffiliated Member	<ul> <li>The nonaffiliated or outside member represents the interests of the general public and must NOT be: [2.31(b)(3)(ii), Policy #15]</li> <li>a member of the immediate family of a person who is affiliated with the research facility</li> <li>a laboratory animal user at any research facility</li> <li>a person with a financial interest in the facility, such as an animal supplier</li> <li>compensated to an amount which jeopardizes the member's status as a nonaffiliated member</li> <li>Compensation for the nonaffiliated member may include:</li> <li>[Policy #15]</li> <li>travel expenses</li> <li>parking</li> <li>a modest monetary payment which does not:</li> <li>become an important source of income</li> <li>influence voting on the IACUC</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Examples of nonaffiliated members include, but are not limited to:</li> <li>clergy</li> <li>retirees</li> <li>humane society volunteers or employees</li> <li>practicing veterinarians</li> <li>physicians</li> <li>biologists not conducting animal research</li> <li>bioethicists</li> <li>non-research staff members from other institutions</li> </ul>
