

<b>EXIT BRIEFING</b>	<p>The exit briefing is the time to summarize everything that occurred during the inspection.</p>
	<p>The exit briefing should be conducted with the designated research facility representative(s), such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Attending Veterinarian</li><li>• IACUC Chairperson</li><li>• Institutional Official</li><li>• Quality Assurance Officer</li><li>• Government Liaison</li><li>• Compliance Officer</li><li>• Facility Director</li></ul> <p>Take as much time as necessary during this opportunity to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• discuss the noncompliant items in detail with the research facility representative(s)</li><li>• assess his/her understanding of the problem(s)</li><li>• discuss what the research facility may do to correct the problem, if asked</li><li>• make sure that research facility representative understands what is expected</li><li>• educate him/her about animal welfare and the AWA regulations and standards</li></ul> <p>The exit briefing includes, but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• presenting the research facility representative with a copy of the inspection report</li><li>• reading the inspection report with the research facility representative</li><li>• reviewing the details of the inspection report</li><li>• answering questions</li><li>• obtaining signatures</li></ul>
