

How to Receive Your Certificate of Completion

When you have completed the series, requests for the Certificate of Completion must be sent first to the State emergency management agency for verification.

Include date and place, as well as name of the course manager, for each course completed.

The State agency will then send the request to the Emergency Management Institute (EMI) for a Certificate of Completion. This is signed by the EMI Superintendent and sent to the State Director for signature and award to the Student.
