SUBJECT: Continuation of April 2003 Change Request (CR2425): Create Import/Export Functionality between the Medicare Claims System (MCS) and the Provider Enrollment Chain Ownership System (PECOS)

The following table lists the Change Requests (CR) that make up the entire PECOS/MCS/VMS/PES/PENS CR Package for the July 2003 Release: (Highlighted row indicates the current CR.)

2527	Continuation of April 2003 Change Request (CR2427): Process all Medicare Part B provider enrollments in the Provider Enrollment Chain Ownership System (PECOS). Create Import/Export Functionality between Viable Medicare System (VMS) and the Provider Enrollment Chain Ownership System (PECOS).

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. **Background:** PECOS Release 3 is scheduled to go live for carrier use in October 2003. With this release, all Medicare carriers must enter all Provider/Supplier enrollment data into PECOS. Carrier Supplier/Provider enrollment data will no longer be entered into PES or PENS. All functions associated with provider enrollment will be handled by PECOS. PECOS will assume the responsibility for communicating with UPIN to obtain the providers' UPIN number and will work with the system maintainers of UPIN to develop import/export functions. PECOS will also assume the responsibility of communicating provider data to MCS and VMS and will work with the MCS and VMS system maintainers to develop the necessary export/import functions. This CR contains the requirements that will be used for the analysis and design phase for the July release and will be used for coding and testing and implementation for the October 2003 release.

- B. Policy:** Collection and retention of CMS 855 enrollment data has been cleared through a Paperwork Reduction Act Notice in the **Federal Register**. The authority for the various types of data to be collected is found in multiple sections of the Social Security Act and Code of Federal Regulations. Specifically in Sections 1816, 1819, 1833, 1834, 1842, 1861, 1866 and 1891 of the Act and 42 CFR Subchapter E.

2	When PECOS receives an extract file from MCS, PECOS should create a file/report that confirms that the extract file was processed correctly.

PECOS will send provider data extracts to the MCS system. PECOS will accept a file from MCS containing any inactive providers as well as confirmation that the PECOS extract to MCS was processed successfully.

- Testing should validate that MCS and PECOS can create and process extract files from each other.


