Subchapter 1. General Provisions.

- 1.1 <u>Restrictions on Use of Personality Tests</u>. The prohibition on the use of personality tests in any personnel action affecting employees or positions in the competitive service (FPM 337, 1-5) applies to all personnel actions affecting employees and positions in the excepted service in the Department.
 - A. Neither the Department nor any bureau will submit proposals for the use of any personality test to the Office of Personnel Management.
- B. There will be no requirement in any contract with the Department or any of its bureaus that personality tests be administered to any contractor's employees.
- C. The Department and its bureaus will not undertake research in the area of personality tests, and they will not request any private firm to undertake such research.
- 1.2 Methods for Determining Qualifications. As appropriate, examining criteria, procedures, and systems in the Department will be consistent with FPM Supplement 271-1, Development of Qualification Standards, FPM Supplement 271-2, Tests and Other Applicant Appraisal Procedures, FPM Supplement 335-1, Evaluation of Employees for Promotion and Internal Placement, and the Uniform Guidelines on Employee Selection Procedures.
