370 DM 353,3.1

Subchapter 3. Agency Action in Employee's Absence.

3.1 General Obligation. Each bureau is responsible for establishment and maintenance of a system which will safeguard the rights of employees who are absent because of compensable injury or service with the Armed Forces. The system will include provisions for maintaining records necessary to assure that the rights of such employees are preserved, including their rights to consideration for promotion.

Appendix B. Agency Action When Employee Returns

.1 Policy. Employees returning from military duty shall be given all possible assistance in restoring them to duty and in obtaining the full rights and benefits to which they are entitled in connection with their Federal employment.
