#### **Questionnaire Section Characteristics:**

#### **Questionnaire Section Description:**

The questions in this section covered lifetime and recent (past 12 months) use of alcohol for ages 20 years and over. The variable name prefix is ALQ.

#### **Interview Setting:**

At the mobile examination center using NHANES Computer Assisted Personal Interview (CAPI) software.

### **Mode of administration:**

Personal (face-to-face) interview by trained interviewers. Interviews were conducted in English or Spanish.

## Eligible sample and any section-specific exclusion criteria:

Sample persons aged 20 years and older were eligible. Special use data files on alcohol use for participants 12-19 years (MEC Audio-CASI interview) will be available through the NCHS Research Data Center.

Mentally impaired individuals or participants who were unable to comprehend English or Spanish were excluded.

## **Quality Control During Data Collection:**

The NHANES CAPI system had built-in consistency checks, including range checks, valid response checks, and checks for logical relationships.

### **Analytic Notes:**

Information on alcohol intake in the 24 hour time period prior to the NHANES health examination was included in the 24-hour dietary recall interview, a component of the
