
Gonorrhea - Reported rates for 15-19 year old females by race and ethnicity: United States, 1981-1997






Gonorrhea - Reported rates for 15-19 year old males by race and ethnicity: United States, 1981-1997






Gonorrhea - Age- and gender-specific rates: United States, 1997




Gonorrhea - Age-specific rates among women 10-44 years of age: United States 1981-1997

Rate (per 100,000 population)






Gonorrhea - Age-specific rates among men 10-44 years of age: United States, 1981-1997






Gonorrhea - Rates in selected U.S. cities of >200,000 population, 1981-1997 and the Healthy People year 2000 objective



Gonorrhea - Reported rates: United States, 1970-1997 and the Healthy People year 2000 objective




Gonorrhea - Rates by gender: United States, 1981-1997 and the Healthy People year 2000 objective


