



Who We Are

The Small Business Government Wide Acquisition Contracts Center provides federal agencies access to quality contracts with Small Businesses that offer best value as well as economic feasibility, thus ultimately serving the taxpayer. At the same time, we endeavor to serve the small business community by awarding contracts that recognize diversity and facilitate economic development.

The Small Business Government-Wide Acquisition Contracts (GWAC) Center is one of three GWAC Centers established by the General Services Administration (GSA). The GWAC Centers award and administer contracts for GSA Federal Technology Service (FTS).

FTS offers regional and national Client Support Centers (CSC) that act as the retail sales arm of FTS. Their primary role is to service clients and therefore provide value-added technical and acquisition support to the client agency. The CSCs are the primary customer of the Small Business GWAC Center. The secondary clients are those who request delegation of authority to use the contracts.

The Small Business GWAC Center manages two major product/service lines. The first product/service line is the 8(a) Multiple Award Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (MAIDIQ) contracts for Information Technology Products and Services. The 8(a) MAIDIQ contracts have a unique market niche as the contract is reserved for 8(a) industry partners. The use of the contract fulfills a social mission for the GSA as agencies can receive credit toward their procurement preference goals.

The second major product/service line, and the subject of this publication, is the newest initiative for a multiple award HUBZone Information Technology Services Contract. This product line also has a unique market niche as the contract is reserved for companies certified as a HUBZone, or *Historically Underutilized Business Zone*. The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) determines HUBZone status. The use of the contract also fulfills a social mission for GSA, as agencies will receive HUBZone credit toward their 3 percent statutory goal.

Introduction

Objectives

This ordering guide is intended to help end users, GSA ordering offices and industry partners use the HUBZone Contracts awarded by the Small Business Government Wide Acquisition Contracts Center. These contracts are Multiple Award Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity, and cover seven Functional Areas (FA) designated by the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) listed below:

- FA1 NAICS 514191 On-Line Information Services
- FA2 NAICS 514199 All Other Information Services
- FA3 NAICS 514210 Data Processing Services
- FA4 NAICS 541511 Custom Computer Programming Services
- FA5 NAICS 541512 Computer Systems Design Services
- FA6 NAICS 541513 Computer Facilities Management Services
- FA7 NAICS 541519 Other Computer Related Services

HUBZone Program Requirements

These contracts enable federal agencies to fulfill their information technology requirements through the utilization of businesses that are located in HUBZones. As of October 1, 2000, all federal buying agencies must abide by the HUBZone Program requirements, Public Law 105-135. Agencies have annual goals for the HUBZone Program of 3% in Fiscal Year 2003. Additional information and background descriptions for NAICS may be found on the web at www.census.gov/epcd/www/naics.html.

Scope

The scope of the contracts includes all products and services necessary to meet the requesting activity's requirements derived from the applicable NAICS code definition, all within the context of a HUBZone set-aside.

The geographical scope of coverage is worldwide and organizational scopes of coverage are those entities authorized in GSA Order ADM 4800.2E (see Appendix IV).

The Small Business Administration allows qualified HUBZone small business concerns (SBCs) to use any manufacturer for supplies (using the HUBZone GWAC definition of supplies), including a large business, for HUBZone contracts at or below \$25,000 in total value. The HUBZone GWAC permits this on each and every Request For Proposal/Request For Quote (RFQ/RFP) and Order. If a HUBZone SBC is the manufacturer of the supplies, there is no limit on the supplies pursuant to the non-manufacturer's rule. Quotes/proposals for supplies above \$25,000 require that the HUBZone SBC provide the product of a HUBZone manufacturer, or for the procurement to be handled using side-by-side acquisitions, the first for the items within the GWAC scope, and a second for the items off of the GWAC in accordance with a method of the contracting officer's choice pursuant to proper practice.

Functional Area Descriptions

Functional Area 1 NAICS 514191 - On-Line Information Services

This U.S. industry comprises Internet access providers, Internet service providers, and similar establishments primarily engaged in providing direct access through telecommunications networks to computer-held information compiled or published by others.

Functional Area 2 NAICS 514199 - All Other Information Services

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in providing information services (except news syndicates, libraries, archives, and online information access). Activities performed by establishments in this industry include telephone-based information recordings and information search services on a Contract basis.

Functional Area Descriptions

Functional Area 5 NAICS 541512 - Computer Systems Design Services

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in planning and designing computer systems that integrate computer hardware, software, and communication technologies. The hardware and software components of the system may be provided by this establishment or company as part of integrated services or may be provided by third parties or vendors. These establishments often install the system and train and support users of the system.

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in providing on-site management and operation of clients' computer systems and/or data processing facilities. Establishments providing computer systems or data processing facilities support services are included in this industry.

Functional Area 7 NAICS 541519 - Other Computer Related Services

This U.S. industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in providing computer-related services (except custom programming, systems integration design, and facilities management services). Establishments providing computer disaster recovery services or software installation services are included in this industry.

Competition Requirements

Fair Opportunity to compete shall be provided to all Contract holders in the applicable Functional Area pool on all Requests For Quotes/Requests for Proposals (RFQ/RFP) and Orders exceeding \$2,500.00, unless one or more of the four statutory Fair Opportunity exceptions found in Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 16.505 applies. Exceptions shall be documented in accordance with FAR 16.5. These are the **only** exceptions.

- The agency need for the supplies or services are so urgent that providing a fair opportunity would result in unacceptable delays;
- Only one awardee is capable of providing the supplies or services required at the level of quality required because the supplies or services ordered are unique or highly specialized;
- The order must be issued on a sole-source basis in the interest of economy and efficiency as a logical follow-on to an order already issued under the contract, provided that all awardees were given a fair opportunity to be considered for the original order; or
- It is necessary to place an order to satisfy a minimum guarantee.

The Government may disseminate RFQ/RFPs via the GSA FTS IT Solutions Shop (ITSS) online ordering system at <u>http://it-solutions.gsa.gov</u>, facsimile, e-mail, commercial mail carrier or other electronic means. The use of any one of the preceding mediums to broadcast an RFQ/RFP notice to all Contract holders in the applicable Functional Area pool satisfies the Fair Opportunity notification requirement.

Competitive award criteria will be established in the RFQ/RFP (price will always be a criterion). Past performance was a part of the criteria for award for this program. Contracting Officers are encouraged to use it as part of the criteria for Orders expected to exceed \$100,000. References and past performance information for specific vendors can be requested from the vendor. Either best value/tradeoff or low price - technically acceptable evaluations are authorized at the RFQ/RFP level, with a preference for the former. The government may require oral presentations at the order level. The government may evaluate guotations without discussions; therefore, each initial quote should contain the best terms. Quotes are due within 5 working days (Monday through Friday) of issuance of the RFQ/RFP unless another response time is specifically identified in the RFQ/RFP. Quotes shall remain valid for a period of not less than 60 calendar days if the minimum acceptance period is not stated in the RFQ/RFP. Although ceiling line item pricing has already been determined fair and reasonable based upon adequate price competition, government Contracting Officers are required to ensure that order pricing is fair and reasonable for their specific requirements. Hardware, software, and other IT items which fall within the scope of the contract may also be procured at the order level. A multi-phased approach to procurement is acceptable wherein all contractors are given a fair opportunity to opt in or out.

How to Order from GSA FTS 3 Steps

Doing business with GSA requires just three documents:

- 1. A signed interagency Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) or Service Agreement
- 2. Statement of Work (SOW) used for technology or telecommunications services projects or Bill of Materials (BOM) used for hardware or software projects
- 3. Funding document

Client/customer approval for the items described in SOW/BOM based on the price and availability proposed by an industry partner is required.

GSA FTS Client Support Centers:

- · Issue and manage delivery and task orders against contracts
- Deliver (resell) solutions to our clients

Delegations of Authority

Federal agencies that wish to conduct their own procurements may also use the HUBZone GWAC through a delegation of authority.

Delegations of authority are easy to request. At a minimum, we require two pieces of information to get started: 1) a request via e-mail from an e-mail account having a ".gov" or ".mil" suffix listing the name(s) of the party(ies) for whom authority is being requested; and 2) a copy of the warrant for each contracting officer for whom authority is being requested. The warrant(s) may accompany the e-mail as a scanned attachment, or may be faxed into us separately, but soon after the original request. We will then validate the information received. When we deem the request appropriate and after proper training, we will issue a delegation of authority to be countersigned by the covered contracting officer(s).

Guidance on Order Preparation

The ordering official responsible for the RFQ/RFP will provide a description of the requirement, which will include some or all of the following:

- A statement of work and/or bill of materials
- A desired completion date along with milestones and/or delivery schedule
- The authorized order types available under this contract (i.e., Firm Fixed Price, Time & Materials, Fixed Price Award Fee)
- Any change from the standard response deadline
- Evaluation factors
- Any special instructions, conditions, notices, performance measures/metrics, etc.
- The applicable Section 508 accessibility standards from 36 CFR 1194

Orders shall contain, to the maximum extent practicable, performance based statements of work with meaningful performance measures/metrics. There is a useful Best Practices Guide issued by the Office of Federal Procurement Policy available on the web at http://oamweb.osec.doc.gov/pbsc/index.html

Funding for each Order shall be at the Order Level, not at the Contract Level.

Services and supplies will be ordered by:

- Issuance of Written Orders on GSA Form 300, Standard Form 1449 or DD Form 1155 using ITSS or other authorized agency form distributed by mail, fax or e-mail attachment. Oral Orders are not authorized.
- One copy of delegated orders shall be sent to the address listed in Appendix I unless issued through ITSS.

At completion of performance, the client agency is required by Federal Acquisition Regulation to complete a past performance questionnaire. An on-line form is available on the HUBZone GWAC website at <u>www.gsa.gov/hubzone</u>.

All options shall be priced and evaluated at the time of initial receipt of offers.

Quotes shall contain breakdown of all Supplies, Travel and Other Direct Costs to include both the handling rate and item bare cost.

- Supplies (e.g., equipment, tools, materials)
- •Travel (e.g., transportation and per diem)
- Other Direct Costs (e.g., additional labor categories)

For any disparity of terms and conditions between an order and the actual contract, the terms and conditions of the contract shall prevail.

Industry Partner Responsibilities

All unit prices for line items quoted (for pre-priced labor categories) shall be fully burdened (inclusive of the entire - regular hourly rate, fringe benefits, product price, any other indirect charges, profit, and the 0.75 percent Contact Access Fee (CAF) allocable thereto). When formulating each unit price, the CAF shall be applied last. <u>All</u> options shall be priced at the time of initial quote.

FOB Destination shipping is expected unless otherwise specifically permitted by the RFQ/RFP.

Section 508 compliance assurances shall be included in all applicable quotes.

Industry Partners are encouraged, but are <u>not</u> required, to quote on all requirements sent to them. Failure to quote on any RFQ/RFP in no way jeopardizes a firm's ability to respond to future RFQ/RFPs.

No work will be performed, no debt or obligation accrued and no payment will be made except as authorized by a bona-fide written Order signed by a duly warranted CO having FTS Order authority or delegated authority for this program.

All Industry Partners are required to register in the FTS on-line ordering system known as IT Solutions Shop, or ITSS (<u>http://it-solutions.gsa.gov</u>). Industry Partners will need to maintain complete up-to-date registrations and diligently monitor their accounts in ITSS.

All Industry Partners are required to register in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) located on the Business Partner Network website at (<u>www.bpn.gov</u>). Industry Partners will need to maintain complete up-to-date registrations and diligently monitor their accounts in CCR.

Performance Requirements (see contract for complete listing)

- The Contractor shall be bound by the terms and conditions in the Contract and in Orders.
- Maximum Order amount not to exceed is \$2.5 billion for the program, and decreases by value of orders issued
- Contractors are required to pay 0.75 percent Contract Access Fee and submit a Cost Recovery Report to the Small Business GWAC Center monthly. (See contract for detailed instructions.)

Small Business Government-Wide Acquisition Contracts Center **Responsibilities**

Only Small Business GWAC Center Contracting Officers are authorized to modify Contract terms and conditions, and administer the contracts.

Only Small Business GWAC Center Contracting Officers are authorized to delegate authority for purchasing against the contracts.

All warranted Contracting Officers of the Federal Technology Service and delegated contracting officials may place orders directly with awarded industry partners. See Appendix II for a Regional Client Support Center listing.

Only a warranted Contracting Officer having Order authority may make any required change to a previously issued Order and the change must be in writing.
