# Great Basin Prevention/Education Working Committee Three Year Strategic Plan (2003 – 2005)

#### **VISION STATEMENT:**

The Great Basin Fire Prevention/Education Working Committee supports and promotes a comprehensive fire prevention/education/mitigation program, which reduces suppression costs, loss of lives, infrastructure damages and natural resource damages.

#### **STRATEGY:**

The following strategies have been identified to meet fire/prevention/education/mitigation needs, through the year 2005. The Great Basin Prevention/Education Working Committee will:

- 1. Support events and projects that have been targeted to meet specific fire prevention/education/mitigation problems in the Great Basin.
  - □ Provide seed monies to initiate local prevention programs
  - □ Sponsor Great Basin-wide events and projects and encourage partnerships to contribute to prevention funding

#### 2. Provide educational opportunities:

- □ Provide current prevention/education/mitigation information through Internet technology
- □ Sponsor public education programs
- □ Provide a list of materials with ordering instructions to field offices
- □ Encourage field offices to identify user groups that could benefit from use of existing fire prevention/education/mitigation materials
- □ Utilize public affairs and non-fire personal in prevention/education/mitigation programs

#### 3. Provide training opportunities:

- □ Evaluate training programs
- □ Sponsor and support Interagency Fire Prevention/Education Workshops

### 4. Facilitate communications and information sharing between all fire agencies in the Great Basin

- Disseminate information throughout the Great Basin based on committee member responsibilities
- Maintain the Great Basin Fire Prevention Directory with bi-annual updates (updated at the Fall Committee meeting to be distributed at the Annual Workshop)
