SUBJECT: Notification of Medlearn Matters (MM) Article for Confidential Change Request (CR) 3301

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: This One-Time Notice (OTN) informs contractors that a Medlearn Matters article will be released for CR 3301 (Coverage by Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans for National Coverage Determinations (NCD) Services Not Previously Included in the MA Capitated Rates).
