




Technology Commercialization Office

TCO Services

TCO provides a broad range of services to help LANL staff members and fledgling entrepreneurs who wish to commercialize their technology or perhaps start a business based on a Laboratory technology. We also work within the Laboratory to identify, evaluate, and prioritize technologies with commercialization potential.

Our staff of technology commercialization executives, MBA interns and business development consultants help LANL technical staff or aspiring entrepreneurs evaluate and implement the different paths to commercialization. Specific services include the following:
