## TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX

## SEC. 21.7.4 EXEMPTIONS

(Amended by Ordinance Nos. 159773, effective May 24, 1985 and 164961, operative August 1, 1989)

No tax shall be imposed upon:

- (a) Any person as to whom, or any occupancy as to which, it is beyond the power of the City to impose the tax herein provided;
- (b) Any Federal or State of California officer or employee while on official business and when payment for such occupancy is made by duly authorized voucher or other instrument of payment issued by the governing agency;
- (c) Any officer or employee of a foreign government who is exempt by reason of express provision of the federal law or international treaty;
- (d) Any person to whom rent is charged at the rate of \$2.00 per day or less.
- (e) Any person as to whom, or any occupancy as to which, rent is paid from funds administered by the Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program.

No exemption shall be granted under subsections (a), (b) or (c) except upon a claim therefore made at the time rent is collected and under penalty of perjury upon a form prescribed by the City Clerk.

It shall be the duty of an operator to keep and maintain written documentation in support of each exemption granted under subsections (a), (b), (c) and (d) for a period of three (3) years, and subsection (e) for a period of four (4) years.
