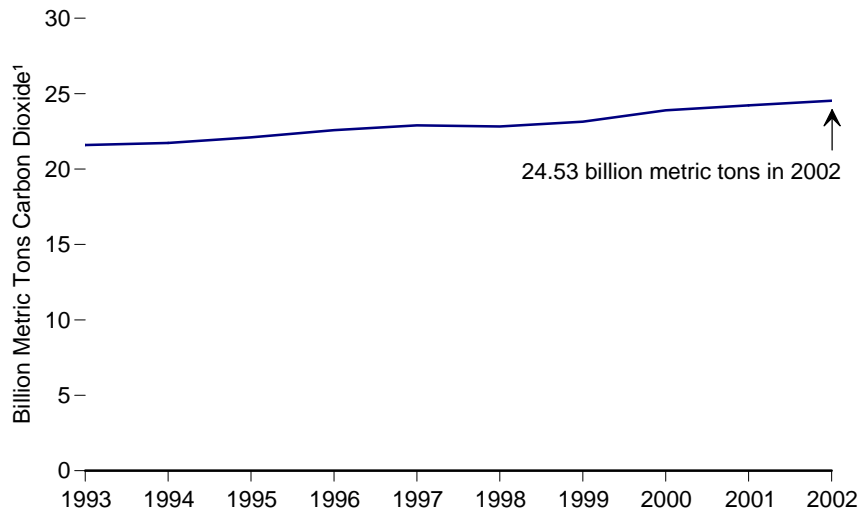
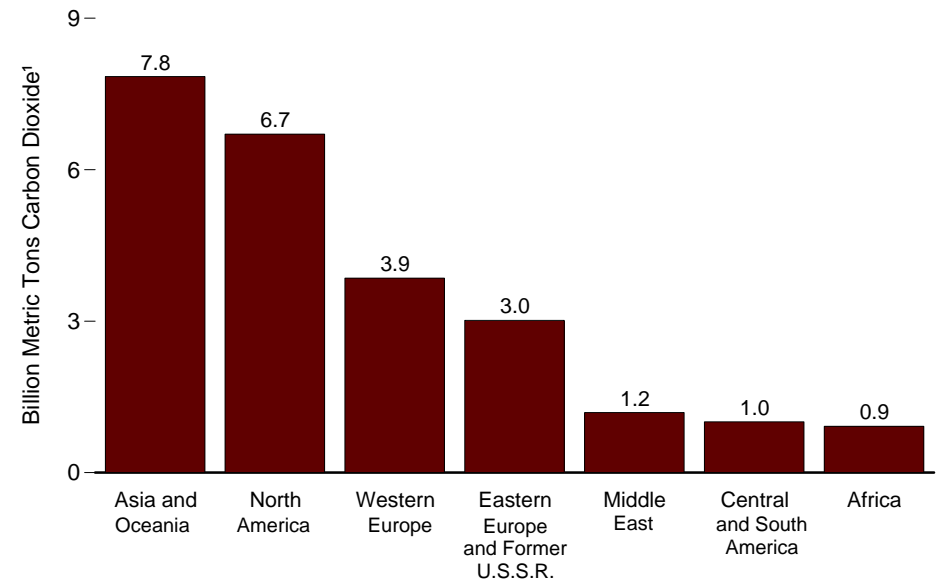


Figure 11.19 World Carbon Dioxide Emissions from Energy Consumption

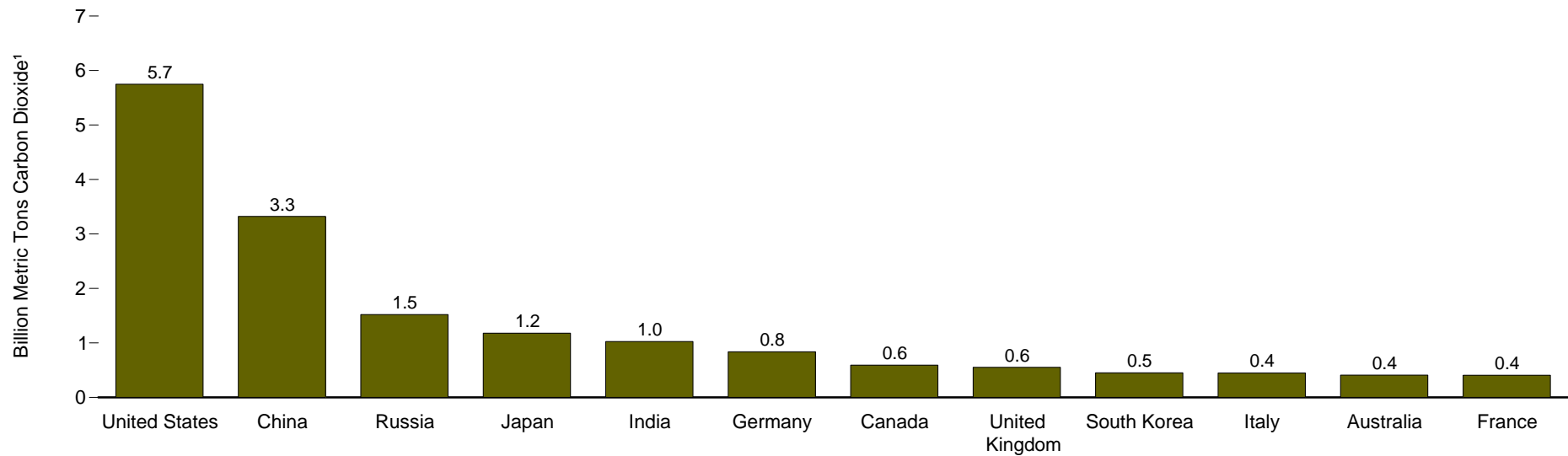
World, 1993-2002
