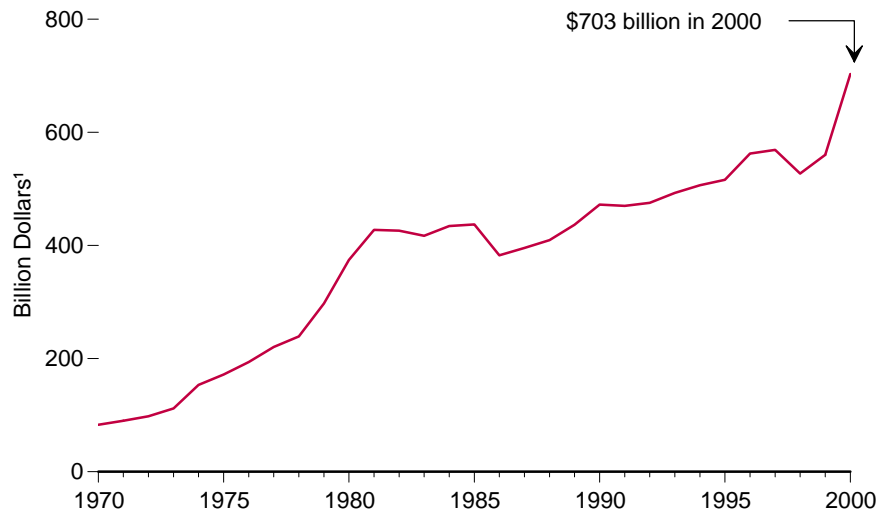
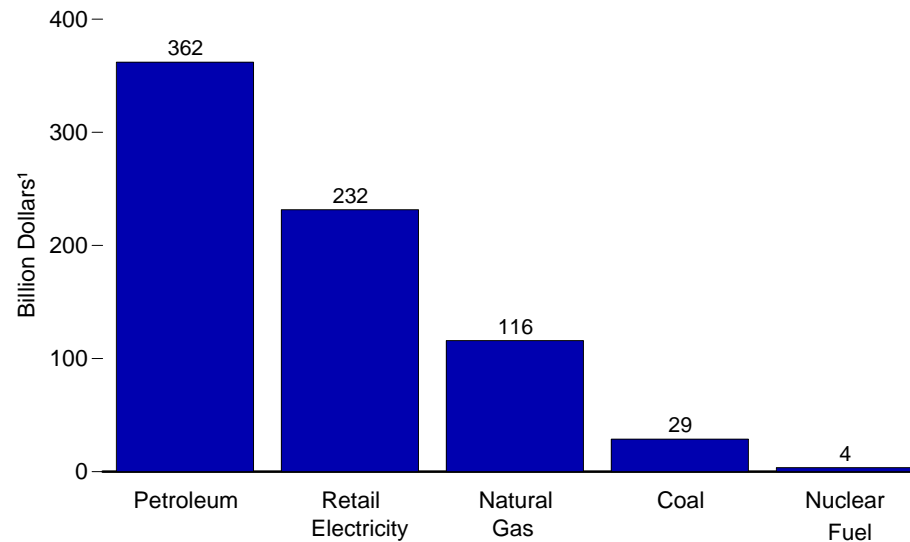


**Figure 3.4 Consumer Expenditure Estimates for Energy**

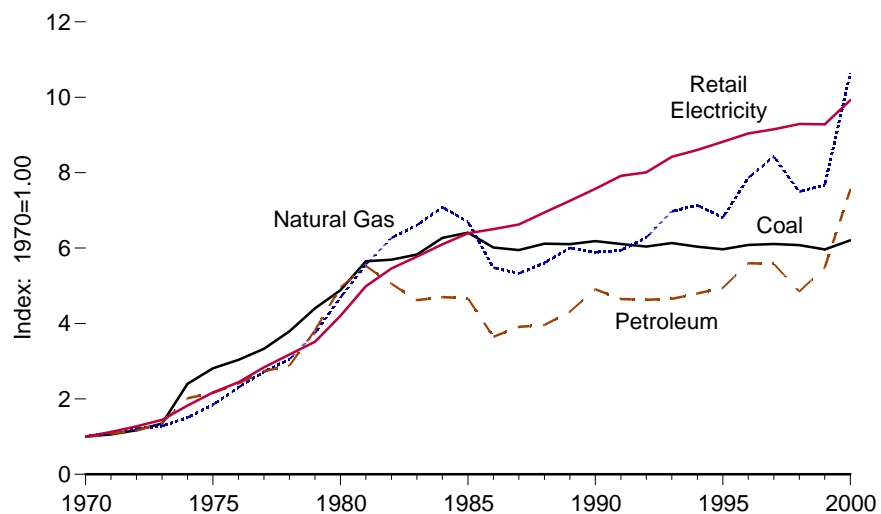
**Total Energy, 1970-2000**



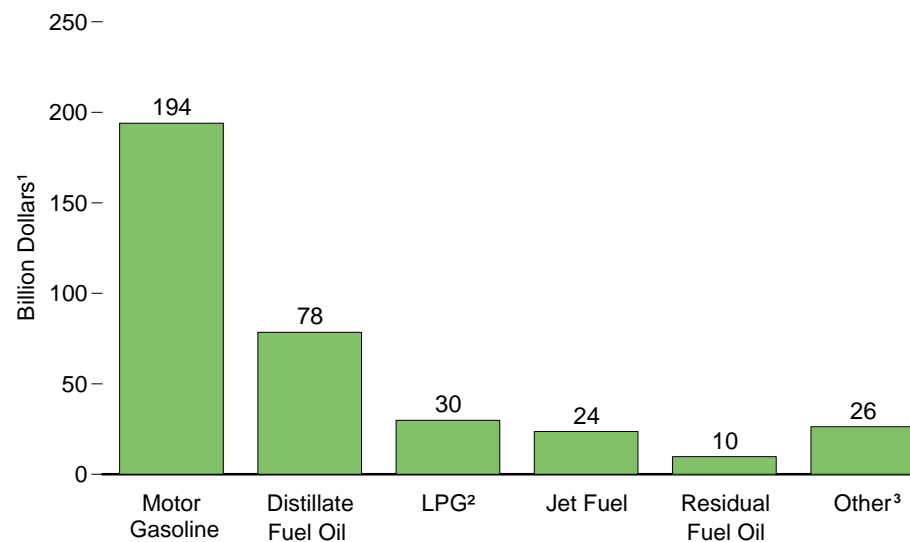
**By Energy Type, 2000**
